I delivered the collective payment for the ads to the Journal.**

**I am unaware that Mr. Power had a formal PAC or group conducting his candidacy. If one did exist our handful of supporters were never involved with them.**

**As far as your list of Allegations are concerned, I believe all are moot points. None of his friends, including me, who helped defray the expense of two ads run in the San Juan Journal individually contributed more than \$500.00. Mr. Power was neither directly involved with the ads nor, to my knowledge, did he ever see the ads prior to their **appearance** in the weekly Journal.**

**I do not recall receiving the noted complaint dated November 2nd.**

**I have now contacted Mr. Power and learned that he sent an email to PDC on November 19, 2018 and has informed the PDC that he intends to amend his filings to include the expenditures as contributions and that he is awaiting instructions from PDC on how he is to proceed.**
