I am supplying this in reference to PDC Case Number 42586.

First and foremost, prior to paying for the advertisement my colleagues and I realized that any further financial contribution by me would be in excess of the contribution maximums. Accordingly, I did not end up contributing financially to the cost of the print advertisement -- thought it says so in the advertisement itself.

Secondly, I understand that the candidate, Nicholas Power, contacted the PDC via email on November 19, 2018 and has informed the PDC that he intends to amend his filings to include the expenditures as contributions and that Mr. Power is awaiting instructions from the PDC on how he is to proceed. It is my understanding that this will provide adequate disclosure. Please advise if this is not your understanding.

Finally, I do not understand how a casual meeting between friends to support a candidate could possibly result in the formation of a PAC. We met only once to support a local candidate, we have no officers, no by-laws, or ANY formal structure whatsoever.

I hope that with this information this matter can be concluded.
