Thank you for the opportunity to respond, I will respond to the points one by one as the PDC has distilled them.

1) Overlimit Contribution.

The complainant argues that Don Pollard's payment for a newspaper ad constitutes an overlimit contribution because he already made a max contribution.

Ultimately, Don Pollard did not contribute anything to the newspaper ads, so there was no overlimit contribution.

2) Failure to report the ad on forms C3/C4.

I mistakenly understood that this would be reported as an electioneering communication by the group that took out the ad, which it apparently was not.

Please advise if you would like me to report this on amended forms -- and, if so -- how I should report it. This is not clear.

3) Failure to accurately report candidate's personal funds expended in support of election campaign.

This point was mentioned in the PDC's complaint summary, but I don't see the specific allegation in the complaint. I believe I have reported all items I've spent personal money on as an in-kind contribution to the campaign. But, if I have reported something incorrectly, I am happy to correct it.

Thank you again for allowing me to respond, please advise me on how you would like me to modify my reports if that's what you want me to do.
