We have reviewed the complaint filed by Cheryl Aichele on December 7th 2018.

On the behalf of the 17th Legislative District Democratic Central Committee, also known as the 17LDDCC, I can make the current responses to the complaint:

- Any complaints regarding violating bylaws by its members or Executive Board/Committee are an internal matter of the 17LDDCC.
- These bylaws complaints should be submitted to the 17LDDCC for review and action if needed.
- The 17LDCC's previous response to PDC case 16475 addresses many of these allegations presented in this complaint.
- There is no evidence presented in the complaint indicating that money was earmarked by the 17LDDCC.

As stated in previous 17LDDCC responses to complaints, the 17LDDCC has been working to prevent similar errors moving forward.
