RE: RESPONSE TO PDC – Birney, Angela; Marchione, John; Padhye, Tanika: Alleged violation of RCW 42.17A.555 for misuse of public facilities to support Candidate Birney (EY 19; Jan 19)

Dear Mx. Blackhorn,

The purpose of this letter is to refute the complaint and ask that the PDC issue a Case Closed with No Evidence of Violations finding.

There was no campaign event at Redmond City Hall on January 22, 2019. Nor was there a public meeting or any violation of the Open Public Meetings Act. What Mr. Koeppen witnessed was Councilmember Padhye providing a tour to a troop of Scouts for them to earn their "Citizenship in the Community" merit badge.

Councilmember Padhye invited Council President Birney and me to attend and answer questions in the City Council Chambers. The Mayor and Council President represent City leadership and addressing visitors are part of the customary duties of those positions. It is also usual and customary for Councilmembers and me to provide tours of City Hall for youth organizations.

To demonstrate that this activity is usual and customary, please find attached the following emails:

Troop 520 Redmond Citizenship in the Community, originally dated **January 5, 2017**, requesting a date to satisfy their "Citizenship in the Community" merit badge, emailed to the Mayor from Steven Ekren.

Request for Feedback, on FLL (first lego league) project, originally dated **October 22, 2017**, requesting a date with Councilmember Birney to discuss water usage for a school project, emailed to Councilmember Birney and staff member of the Cascade Water Alliance.

Meeting with Boy Scouts, originally dated **December 5, 2017**, Councilmember Padhye notifying Council that she will lead a group of Boy Scouts in a conversation in the Council Chambers to satisfy their "Citizenship in the Community" merit badge, emailed to the Mayor and City Council from Councilmember Padhye.

Meeting request, originally dated **May 9, 2018**, requesting a date to discuss a reusable bag ordinance for Redmond, emailed to Councilmember Margeson from Melissa Stuart.

Cub Scout Pack #591 Visit to Redmond City Council - January 8, 2018 (sic 2019) - 7:30 PM, originally dated **November 13, 2018**, requesting a date to learn about city government, emailed to Councilmember Padhye from Fran Shigley.

In addition, I would like to specifically address some of the assertions in Mr. Koeppen's email:

- Councilmember Birney was never mentioned as a candidate for any office, including mayor.
- We were asked why we ran for office in the first place. We never were asked about future campaigns, and we did not discuss them.
- While civic groups and other governments have used our Council Chambers for meetings, no one can use the Chambers for campaign events.
- This gathering did not meet the standard of an Open Public Meeting. While four Councilmembers were in the Council Chambers at one time or another, only two Councilmembers were engaged in the conversation, and there was no discussion of public business. The dialogue centered upon the role of municipal government in everyday lives.

I hope my explanation and the attached emails demonstrate that no campaigning took place in public facilities, there was not a violation of the Open Public Meeting Act, and the elected officials involved were performing their job duties by educating the public on the functions of the City.


