Subject: Complaint regarding Tanisha Harris (3), PDC Case 46472

Dear Glen Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review of the complaint you filed on February 4, 2019. Your complaint alleged that Tanisha Harris may have violated RCW 42.17A.235 for failure to timely and accurately file Monetary Contribution reports (C-3 reports) and Summary Full Campaign Contribution and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports), disclosing a \$1,000 contribution to the 2016 Clark County Council Campaign.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations; the applicable statutes, rules, and reporting requirements; the response provided by Tanisha Harris; the applicable PDC reports filed by Respondent; and queried the Respondent’s data in the PDC contribution and expenditure database, to determine whether the record supports a finding of one or more violations.

Based on staff’s review, we found the following:

- On July 5, 2016, the Tanisha Harris campaign received a \$2,000 contribution from the Harry Truman Fund, and believing them to be subject to Caucus Committee contribution limits, attributed the entire amount to the Primary Election.
- On January 2, 2019, in the process of addressing allegations in PDC Case 43859, PDC staff informed the Harris campaign that the Harry Truman Fund is not subject to Caucus Committee contribution limits, directed them to reattribute any eligible funds toward the General, and provide a list of any amount in excess of contribution limits.
- On January 7, 2019, the Harris campaign complied with the request from PDC staff, and amended their C-3 report to show \$1,000 attributed toward the Primary Election contribution limit, and \$1,000 attributed toward the General Election contribution limit.
- The entire amount was disclosed prior to the election, and these changes do not materially impact the public.

Based on these findings staff has determined that, in this instance, failure to properly attribute contributions received does not amount to an actual violation warranting further investigation.

Tanisha Harris made minor or ministerial errors on required reports, which did not materially impact the public interest. Upon notification of these errors, Tanisha Harris timely amended their reports, making the necessary technical corrections as requested by staff.

Based on this information, the PDC finds that no further action is warranted and has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1).
