Glen Morgan reported an issue (Sat, 2 Feb 2019 at 12:24 PM)

To whom it may concern,

It has come to my attention that registered lobbyist Darcy Nonemacher with The Washington Environmental Council, has violated RCW 42.17A.

**1) Failure to submit recent photograph at time of registration (Violation of RCW 42.17A.605)**

Nonemacher has been a registered lobbyist with the PDC since 2007 and employed by the Washington Public Employees Association since at least 2016. Nonemacher is fully aware of Washington State’s campaign finance laws and the transparency reporting requirements for registered lobbyists, and Nonemacher is experienced enough to comply with them. There is no reason for this failure to comply with the law.
