Glen Morgan reported an issue (Sun, 3 Feb 2019 at 6:05 PM)

To Whom it May Concern --

It has come to my attention that the Campaign to Prevent Fraud and Protect Seniors PAC, has willfully committed a significant violation of **RCW 42.17A**. Additionally, I have reason to believe that other violations of this chapter have occurred beyond what I have identified below.

1) Failure to file accurate, timely C4 reports. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235)

State law requires that candidates and committees file frequent, accurate, reports of contributions, expenditures, in-kind contributions, debt, pledges, and loans (C3s and C4s). The reports must be compliant with both state law and PDC regulations (**WAC 390**).

Unfortunately, the Campaign to Prevent Fraud and Protect Seniors filed a C4 (expenditure) reports almost a month late (See **Report # 100879864**). All told, **\$18,875 of expenditures to Pacifica Law Group were hidden from the public** for almost one month. This is not an amended report. Please note this organization raised and spent millions of dollars and used a very experienced treasurer. There is no excuse for this failure to comply with Washington State campaign finance law.
