This e-mail is a follow-up to the one I sent you on June 15, 2010.

On June 8, 2010, PDC staff sent you a Brief Enforcement Hearing Notice regarding your alleged failure to timely file the Personal Financial Affairs Statement (PDC Form F-1) by April 15, 2010, for your position as a School Director for the Chewelah School District.

After sending out the Brief Enforcement Hearing Notices, we became aware of the mitigating factors listed in your e-mail, primarily the fact that you only served as a School Director for a brief time. We received your F-1 report in the mail with a postmark date of June 16, 2010. We appreciate your completing the F-1 report.

Based on the facts in your e-mail and the receipt of your F-1 report, we are closing your case administratively. Thus, no further enforcement action will be taken.
