I.

Background & Findings

- 1.1 The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) received 69 complaints from Preston Mui of Evergreen Freedom Foundation (EFF) on July 28, 2010, alleging that multiple public agencies may have engaged in reportable lobbying activities but failed to file Reports of Lobbying by State and Local Government Agencies (PDC Form L-5) as required by RCW 42.17.190. One of the complaints alleged that the Port of Seattle may have violated RCW 42.17.190 by failing to file L-5 reports disclosing lobbying activities undertaken during calendar years 2001 through 2009. **See Exhibit 1.**
- 1.2 State agencies, local counties and cities, school, fire and port districts must file L-5 reports disclosing their lobbying expenditures if employees or non-elected officials undertake in-person lobbying in order to influence the passage or defeat of state legislation, or if the agency employs a contract lobbyist. The L-5 reports are due quarterly, according to the reporting schedule. If no reportable lobbying occurs during a calendar quarter, there is no requirement that an L-5 report be filed.
- 1.3 On January 11, 2005, Hull & Associates, Inc., a contract lobbying firm, filed a Lobbyist Registration (PDC Form L-1) disclosing the Port of Seattle had retained the services of Linda Hull to lobby. The L-1 listed Hull & Associates, Inc. would be paid \$3,750 per month to lobby during calendar years 2005 and 2006 by the Port of Seattle, and indicated the firm's sole duty was to lobby on behalf of the port as a contract lobbyist. (Note – on January 18, 2005, Ms. Hull sent an e-mail confirming that Hull & Associates, Inc. changed their name to LMH, Inc.) The L-1 was signed by Terry Finn, State Government Relations Manager for the Port of Seattle.

- 1.4 On January 9, 2007, LMH, Inc., a contract lobbying firm, filed an L-1 disclosing the Port of Seattle had retained the services of LMH, Inc. as a contract lobbyist, and that the firm would be paid \$3,750 per month to lobby during calendar years 2007 and 2008. The L-1 disclosed that LMH, Inc. would have two individuals, Linda Hull and Vicki Austin, who would be lobbying for the firm, and that the firm's sole duty was to lobby on behalf of the Port of Seattle. The L-1 was signed by Mr. Finn for the Port of Seattle.
- 1.5 On January 12, 2009, LMH, Inc. filed an L-1 disclosing the Port of Seattle had retained the services of LMH, Inc. as a contract lobbyist, and that the firm would be paid \$4,000 per month to lobby during calendar years 2009 and 2010. The L-1 also disclosed that LMH, Inc. would have two individuals, Linda Hull and Vicki Austin, who would be lobbying for the firm, and that the firm's sole duty was to lobby on behalf of the Port of Seattle. The L-1 was signed by Mr. Finn for the Port of Seattle.
- 1.6 LMH, Inc. and Hull & Associates filed Monthly Lobbyist Expense reports (PDC Form L-2) disclosing payments made by the Port of Seattle during calendar years 2006 through the first three quarters of 2010 for contract lobbying services.
- 1.7 On October 7, 2010, PDC staff sent a letter informing the Port of Seattle that a complaint had been filed alleging violations of RCW 42.17.190 for agency lobbying activities undertaken during calendar years 2001 through 2009. The letter stated staff had reviewed the public agency lobbying reports filed by the Port of Seattle, and found the last L-5 report was filed on May 30, 2006, for the first quarter of 2006. Staff also found that two additional L-5 reports had also been filed by the Port of Seattle, one for the first quarter of 2003, and one for the first quarter of 2002.
- 1.8 Staff requested the Port of Seattle file the L-5 reports for calendar years 2001, 2004 and 2005, 2007 through 2009, the L-5 report for the last three quarters of calendar years 2002, 2003, and 2006, and L-5 reports for the first three quarters of 2010. The Port of Seattle was informed that the allegations regarding the missing L-5 report for 2001 through 2004, and the first two quarters of 2005 were beyond the PDC's five year statute of limitations for violations of RCW 42.17, and would not be investigated. Staff requested the Port of Seattle file one L-5 report per calendar year for the period 2001 through 2004, and one L-5 report for the first two quarters of calendar year 2005.
- 1.9 The Port of Seattle filed 23 L-5 reports on January 14, 2011, covering the period of calendar years 2001 through 2009, and the first three quarters of 2010. **See Exhibit #2.** Five of the L-5 reports filed by the Port of Seattle disclosed port lobbying activities undertaken on an annual basis during calendar years 2001 through 2005. Those lobbying activities were beyond the five year statute of limitations.
- 1.10 On January 19, 2011, the PDC received a two-page response letter from Clare Impett Gallagher, Port of Seattle State Government Relations Manager, regarding the allegations listed in the complaint letter filed by Mr. Mui. **See Exhibit #3.**

- 1.11 Ms. Gallagher stated that she reviewed the Port of Seattle's filed and on-line records with the PDC, and *"must conclude that we did not properly file the reports for the period in question."* She said the Port of Seattle did hire a contract lobbyist during the timeframes listed in the complaint, and the lobbyist reported the monthly compensation paid by the port. She said on behalf of the port, she regretted *"the lapse in our procedures which failed to ensure proper reporting. I have put measures into place to provide accurate and complete reporting going forward."*
- 1.12 On February 1, 2011, PDC staff opened a formal investigation into the complaint filed by Preston Mui of EFF against the Port of Seattle, and notified the port that staff would be investigating the allegations of failure to timely file L-5 reports disclosing agency lobbying expenses. **See Exhibit #4.**
- 1.13 On February 16, 2011, the PDC received a two-page letter from Ms. Gallagher providing additional information to the allegations in PDC Case No. 11-032.. **See Exhibit #5.** She said the Port of Seattle employed a contract lobbyist during the reporting periods listed in the complaint, and the contract lobbyist disclosed those lobbying activities undertaken on behalf of the port. She went on to state: *"Since we pay our contractor monthly, we should have been reporting each quarter throughout the reporting period and, therefore, our reporting was not done correctly."*
- 1.14 Ms. Gallagher stated the prior State Government Relations Manager left the Port of Seattle in mid-year 2007, and that another Port Manager was assigned those duties, and only lobbied during the 2008 Legislative Session. She said the Port of Seattle had several employee changes that contributed to lack of reporting of public agency lobbying activities such as the department director, and the State Government Relations Manager and his administrative assistant all departing in 2006.
- 1.15 Ms. Gallagher stated with the State Government Relations Manager position being vacant until May of 2008, combined with the employee transitions listed above, *"impacted our ability to ensure regular reporting."* She said the L-5 reporting lapsed entirely after the L-5 report was filed for the first quarter of 2006, and the new administrative assistant hired after that was not aware of the L-5 reporting requirements, and she did not file any L-5 reports. In addition, she said the failure to file the L-5 report was not internally flagged by the Port of Seattle, and there was no mention of the L-5 reporting requirements in the transition materials for any Port of Seattle employees that filled the vacant positions listed above.

Port of Seattle Lobbying Activities (April 1, 2006 through September 30, 2010):

- 1.16 The remaining 18 L-5 reports were filed by the Port of Seattle for the last three quarters of 2006, calendar years 2007 through 2009, and the first three quarters of 2010, and disclosed reportable lobbying expenses totaling \$269,900, as detailed in the chart below. The L-5 reports disclosed \$33,801 in previously un-reported Port of Seattle employee time spent lobbying, and \$233,708 in payments made to contract lobbyists Hull & Associates and LMH, Inc.

1.17 The Port of Seattle also disclosed \$1,500 for brochures and other publications whose principal purpose was to influence legislation incurred during the first quarter of 2009, and \$891 in Port of Seattle funds were spent for employee lobbying-related travel costs. The Port of Seattle reported no employee-related travel costs for the last three quarters of 2006, and calendar years 2007 and 2008.

1.18 The \$233,708 in Port of Seattle lobbying expenses for payments made to contract lobbyists were disclosed by Hull & Associates and LMH, Inc. on Monthly Lobbyist Expense Reports (PDC Form L-2) for the last three quarters of 2006, calendar years 2007 through 2009, and the first three quarters of 2010. The public did have access to that lobbying information through the PDC website by reviewing the L-2 reports filed by the Port Seattle’s registered contract lobbyists or through searching the PDC lobbying database.

Last Three Quarters of 2006:

1.19 The Port of Seattle filed three L-5 reports on January 14, 2011, for the last three quarters of 2006 disclosing \$43,381 in port district funds had been spent lobbying, as detailed below. Of this amount, \$9,501 was for Port of Seattle employee’s time spent lobbying during the last three quarters of 2006, with \$3,167 reported for each quarter. The L-5 reports also disclosed \$33,880 in Port of Seattle funds were spent on contract lobbyists during the last three quarters of 2006, and no funds were reported as being spent for employee lobbying-related travel costs during the year.

- Second quarter of 2006: The L-5 report was filed 1,616 days late and disclosed Port of Seattle lobbying expenses totaling \$14,547, which included \$3,167 for ten percent of the time Terry Finn, State Government Relations Manager, spent lobbying during the quarter. The L-5 report also disclosed \$11,380 in payments made to LMH, Inc. for contract lobbying services during the second quarter of 2006. The L-5 report was due to be filed by July 31, 2006.
- Third quarter of 2006: The L-5 report was filed 1,524 days late and disclosed Port of Seattle lobbying expenses totaling \$14,417, which included \$3,167 for ten percent of the time Terry Finn spent lobbying during the quarter. The L-5 report also disclosed \$11,250 in payments made to LMH, Inc. for contract lobbying services during the third quarter. The L-5 report was due to be filed by October 31, 2006.
- Fourth quarter of 2006: The L-5 report was filed 1,433 days late and disclosed Port of Seattle lobbying expenses totaling \$14,417, which included \$3,167 for ten percent of the time Terry Finn spent lobbying during the quarter. The L-5 report also disclosed \$11,250 in payments made to LMH, Inc. for contract lobbying services during the fourth quarter. The L-5 report was due to be filed by January 31, 2007.

Calendar Year 2007:

1.20 The Port of Seattle filed four L-5 reports on January 14, 2011, for calendar year 2007 disclosing \$53,782 in port district funds had been spent lobbying, as detailed below. Of this amount, \$8,750 was for Port of Seattle employee's time spent lobbying during the first two quarters of 2007. The L-5 reports also disclosed \$45,032 in port district funds were spent on contract lobbyists during 2007, and no port funds were expended for employee lobbying-related travel costs.

- First quarter of 2007: The L-5 report was filed 1,342 days late and disclosed Port of Seattle lobbying expenses totaling \$18,750, which included \$7,500 for 30 percent of the time Terry Finn spent lobbying during the quarter.

The L-5 report disclosed \$11,250 in payments made to LMH, Inc. for contract lobbying services. The L-5 report was due to be filed by April 30, 2007.

- Second quarter of 2007: The L-5 report was filed 1,251 days late and disclosed Port of Seattle lobbying expenses totaling \$12,500, which included \$1,250 for five percent of the time Terry Finn, State Government Relations Manager, spent lobbying during the quarter. The L-5 report also disclosed \$11,250 in payments made to LMH, Inc. for contract lobbying services during the second quarter. The L-5 report was due to be filed by July 31, 2007.
- Third quarter of 2007: The L-5 report was filed 1,159 days late and disclosed Port of Seattle lobbying expenses totaling \$11,282 for payments made to LMH, Inc. for contract lobbying services during the third quarter. There was no reportable Port of Seattle employee time spent lobbying during the quarter. The L-5 report was due to be filed by October 31, 2007.
- Fourth quarter of 2007: The L-5 report was filed 1,067 days late and disclosed Port of Seattle lobbying expenses totaling \$11,250 for payments made to LMH, Inc. for contract lobbying services during the fourth quarter. There was no reportable Port of Seattle employee time spent lobbying during the quarter. The L-5 report was due to be filed by January 31, 2008.

Calendar Year 2008:

1.21 The Port of Seattle filed four L-5 reports on January 14, 2011, for calendar year 2008 disclosing \$58,512 in port district funds had been spent lobbying, as detailed below. Of this amount, \$10,600 was for Port of Seattle employee's time spent lobbying during calendar year 2008. The L-5 reports also disclosed \$47,912 in port district funds were spent on contract lobbyists during the period. No Port of Seattle funds were spent for employee lobbying-related travel costs during the year.

- First quarter of 2008: The L-5 report was filed 976 days late and disclosed Port of Seattle lobbying expenses totaling \$20,750, which included \$9,000 for 30 percent of the time spent lobbying by Henry Yates, Government Affairs Manager for the Port of Seattle, during the quarter.

The L-5 report also disclosed \$11,750 in payments made to LMH, Inc. for contract lobbying services during the first quarter. The L-5 report was due to be filed by April 30, 2008.

- Second quarter of 2008: The L-5 report was filed 885 days late and disclosed Port of Seattle lobbying expenses totaling \$12,731, which included \$700 for one percent of Henry Yates time spent lobbying during the quarter. The L-5 report also disclosed \$12,031 in payments made to LMH, Inc. for contract lobbying services during the second quarter. The L-5 report was due to be filed by July 31, 2008.
- Third quarter of 2008: The L-5 report was filed 793 days late and disclosed Port of Seattle lobbying expenses totaling \$12,450, which included \$450 for two percent of the time Clare Gallagher, State Government Relations Manager, spent lobbying during the quarter. The L-5 report also disclosed \$12,000 for payments made to LMH, Inc. for contract lobbying services during the third quarter. The L-5 report was due to be filed by October 31, 2008.
- Fourth quarter of 2008: The L-5 report was filed 701 days late and disclosed Port of Seattle lobbying expenses totaling \$12,581, which included \$450 for two percent of the time Clare Gallagher spent lobbying during the quarter. The L-5 report also disclosed \$12,131 for payments made to LMH, Inc. for contract lobbying services during the fourth quarter. The L-5 report was due to be filed by January 31, 2009.

Calendar Year 2009:

- 1.22 The Port of Seattle filed four L-5 reports on January 14, 2011, for calendar year 2009 disclosing \$52,845 in port district funds had been spent lobbying, as detailed below. Of this amount, \$2,475 was for Port of Seattle employee's time spent lobbying during calendar year 2009. The L-5 reports also disclosed \$48,384 in port district funds were spent on contract lobbyists, and \$487 in Port of Seattle funds were spent for employee lobbying-related travel costs during the year.

- First quarter of 2009: The L-5 report was filed 610 days late and disclosed Port of Seattle lobbying expenses totaling \$15,102, which included \$1,125 for five percent of the time spent lobbying by Clare Gallagher during the quarter.

The L-5 report also disclosed \$12,073 in payments made to LMH, Inc. for contract lobbying services, \$1,500 for the printing or copying of brochures and other publications whose principal purpose is to influence state legislation, and \$404 in Port of Seattle funds were spent for employee lobbying-related travel costs. The L-5 report was due to be filed by April 30, 2009.

- Second quarter of 2009: The L-5 report was filed 519 days late and disclosed Port of Seattle lobbying expenses totaling \$12,495, which included \$450 for two percent of the time spent lobbying by Clare Gallagher during the quarter. The L-5 report also disclosed \$12,000 in payments made to LMH, Inc. for contract lobbying services, and \$45 in Port of Seattle funds were spent for employee lobbying-related travel costs during the second quarter. The L-5 report was due to be filed by July 31, 2009.
- Third quarter of 2009: The L-5 report was filed 427 days late and disclosed Port of Seattle lobbying expenses totaling \$12,535, which included \$450 for two percent of the time spent lobbying by Clare Gallagher during the quarter. The L-5 report also disclosed \$12,066 in payments made to LMH, Inc. for contract lobbying services, and \$19 in Port of Seattle funds were spent for employee lobbying-related travel costs during the third quarter. The L-5 report was due to be filed by October 31, 2009.
- Fourth quarter of 2009: The L-5 report was filed 335 days late and disclosed Port of Seattle lobbying expenses totaling \$12,714, which included \$450 for two percent of the time spent lobbying by Clare Gallagher during the quarter. The L-5 report also disclosed \$12,245 in payments made to LMH, Inc. for contract lobbying services, and \$19 in Port of Seattle funds were spent for employee lobbying-related travel costs during the fourth quarter. The L-5 report was due to be filed by January 31, 2010.

First Three Quarters of 2010:

- 1.23 The Port of Seattle filed three L-5 reports on January 14, 2011, for the first three quarters of 2010 disclosing \$61,379 in port district funds had been spent lobbying, as detailed below. Of this amount, \$2,475 was for Port of Seattle employee's time spent lobbying during calendar year 2010.
- 1.24 The L-5 reports also disclosed \$58,500 in port district funds were spent on contract lobbyists, and \$404 in Port of Seattle funds were spent for employee lobbying-related travel costs during the year.

- First quarter of 2010: The L-5 report was filed 245 days late and disclosed Port of Seattle lobbying expenses totaling \$21,279, which included \$1,375 for five percent of the time spent lobbying by Clare Gallagher during the quarter. The L-5 report also disclosed \$19,500 in payments made to LMH, Inc. for contract lobbying services, and \$404 in Port of Seattle funds were spent for employee lobbying-related travel costs. The L-5 report was due to be filed by April 30, 2010.
- Second quarter of 2010: The L-5 report was filed 154 days late and disclosed Port of Seattle lobbying expenses totaling \$20,050, which included \$550 for two percent of the time spent lobbying by Clare Gallagher during the quarter. The L-5 report also disclosed \$19,500 in payments made by the Port of Seattle to LMH, Inc. for contract lobbying services. The L-5 report was due to be filed by July 31, 2010.
- Third quarter of 2010: The L-5 report was filed 62 days late and disclosed Port of Seattle lobbying expenses totaling \$20,050, which included \$550 for two percent of the time spent lobbying by Clare Gallagher during the quarter. The L-5 report also disclosed \$19,500 in payments made by the Port of Seattle to LMH, Inc. for contract lobbying services. The L-5 report was due to be filed by October 31, 2010.

II. Scope

- 2.1 PDC staff reviewed the complaint filed on July 28, 2010, by Preston Mui of Evergreen Freedom Foundation (EFF), alleging that the Port of Seattle may have engaged in reportable lobbying activities but failed to file Reports of Lobbying by State and Local Government Agencies (PDC Form L-5) as required by RCW 42.17.190.
- 2.2 PDC staff reviewed the PDC website and Application Extender for L-5 reports filed by the Port of Seattle.
- 2.3 PDC staff also reviewed the following:

- The response submitted by Clare Gallagher on behalf of Port of Seattle on January 19, 2011;
- The Lobbyist Registrations (PDC Forms L-1) filed for 2005, 2007 and 2009 by Hull and Associates and LMC, Inc. listing the Port of Seattle as a Lobbyist Employer;
- The Monthly Lobbyist Expense Reports (PDC Form L-2) submitted by Hull and Associates and LMC, Inc. for the compensation paid by the Port of Seattle to lobby during the last three quarters of 2006, calendar years 2007 to 2009, and the first three quarters of 2010; and
- Additional response submitted by Clare Gallagher on behalf of the Port of Seattle that was received on February 16, 2011.

III. Relevant Statutes

3.1 RCW 42.17.020(31) states in part the following:


“"Lobby" and "lobbying" each mean attempting to influence the passage or defeat of any legislation by the legislature of the state of Washington, or the adoption or rejection of any rule, standard, rate, or other legislative enactment of any state agency under the state Administrative Procedure Act, chapter 34.05 RCW....”

3.2 RCW 42.17.190 states in part the following:

(5) Each state agency, county, city, town, municipal corporation, quasi-municipal corporation, or special purpose district which expends public funds for lobbying shall file with the commission, except as exempted by (d) of this subsection, quarterly statements providing the following information for the quarter just completed:

- (a) The name of the agency filing the statement;
- (b) The name, title, and job description and salary of each elected official, officer, or employee who lobbied, a general description of the nature of the lobbying, and the proportionate amount of time spent on the lobbying;
- (c) A listing of expenditures incurred by the agency for lobbying including but not limited to travel, consultant or other special contractual services, and brochures and other publications, the principal purpose of which is to influence legislation;
- (8) The purpose of this section is to require each state agency and certain local agencies to report the identities of those persons who lobby on behalf of the agency for compensation, together with certain separately identifiable and measurable expenditures of an agency's funds for that purpose. This section shall be reasonably construed to accomplish that purpose and not to require any agency to report any of its general overhead cost or any other costs which relate only indirectly or incidentally to lobbying or which are equally attributable to or inseparable from non-lobbying activities of the agency.



Lobbying Activities from January through March (1st Quarter), 2002

Most Port of Seattle (POS) lobbying activities during the first half of the session (until the first major cutoff) were devoted to legislation concerning the operation of Sea-Tac Airport. POS opposed a number of bills that appeared to impose restrictions on airport operations, including removal of port tax levy, limiting scope of environmental mitigation, imposing labor and environmental regulatory requirements at the airport, establishing an airport mitigation advisory council, and limiting campaign contributions in port commission campaigns. Also opposed airport siting bill that also would have delayed Sea-Tac expansion.

Devoted much of second half of the session in support of statewide and regional transportation funding, including ESHB 2451, ESHB 2969, and E2SSB, 6140. Supported HB 2571, allowing ports acting as their own treasurer to issue either warrants or checks to pay bills, and HB 2450, updating the World Trade Center Act to include electronic services and businesses.

Also lobbied in support of ESHB 2866, delineating regulatory scope of Ecology and Fish and Wildlife in hydraulic permit applications. Worked in support of a compromise on 2SHB 2663, relating to occupational disease benefits for firefighters.

In response to your letter of October 7, 2010 regarding the complaint filed by Mr. Preston Mui and the Port's failure to properly file L-5 reports with the Commission, we have reviewed our files and online records at the Commission, and must conclude that we did not properly file the reports for the period in question. Enclosed please find the records requested in your letter, including an annual report for years 2001 through 2005, and quarterly reports beginning in 2006 through the current filing period of third quarter 2010.

As the reports filed monthly by our contract lobbying firms show, the Port did maintain ongoing contract lobbyists and thus did incur reportable lobbying expenditures throughout each of the years in question, requiring quarterly L-5 reports. On behalf of the Port, I regret the lapse in our procedures which failed to ensure proper reporting. I have put measures into place to provide accurate and complete reporting going forward. Because of changes in personnel this fall, your letter was misfiled and I was not made aware of it until after the response deadline had passed. I appreciate the willingness of Mr. Young to consider my request for an extension in order to provide these records.

In reviewing the Port's involvement in lobbying activity, our level of participation is quite consistent from year to year, and is less involved now than earlier in the decade when many issues related to the construction of the third runway at Sea-Tac Airport were in front of the Legislature. We continue to retain a contract lobbyist, and the primary focus of our engagement with legislators, staff and agency personnel is in the transportation arena, with additional involvement in a revision to public contracting rules in 2008. Where possible, I have noted specific bills and issues on the appropriate quarterly report. I have also included the original material filed by the Port in 2002 and 2003.

On October 7, 2010, you were provided a copy of a complaint received July 28, 2010 from Preston Mui of Evergreen Freedom Foundation, alleging that the Port of Seattle may have failed to report all of its lobbying expenses on PDC form L-5, alleged violations of RCW 42.17.190. We are in receipt of the L-5 reports filed by the Port of Seattle on January 14, 2011, along with a response letter addressing the issues listed in the complaint. The missing L-5 reports covered lobbying activities undertaken by the port during the period 2001 through 2009. Thank you for filing those missing reports and bringing your reports up-to-date.

PDC staff will investigate the allegations with respect to whether the Port of Seattle violated RCW 42.17.190 by failing to timely file L-5 reports of public agency lobbying activities undertaken during the period covering the third quarter of 2005 through 2009.

To assist our investigation, if you would like to supplement your January 14 response to the complaint, please do so in writing **by February 15, 2011**. Please let us know if you will not be providing a supplemental response. All laws cited in this letter can be found on our website, www.pdc.wa.gov, under "Home" and "Laws and Rules." We will notify you of the results when the investigation is complete.

Thank you for your February 1, 2011 letter. As I confirmed with Mr. Young by phone, I am submitting this letter as a supplement to the Port's January 14th response.

As noted in my earlier letter, the Port employed a contract lobbyist during the reporting period in question; the lobbyist reported appropriately regarding the Port contract. Mr. Young provided clarification that the L-5 must be submitted quarterly by the agency when there are reportable expenses incurred in the quarter. Since we pay our contractor monthly, we should have been reporting each quarter throughout the reporting period and, therefore, our reporting was not done correctly.

It's unclear whether there were specific reportable lobbying expenses for the Port state government relations manager outside the first quarter reports submitted through 2006. I did submit the salary amount for the government relations manager on the reports, to provide a more complete disclosure of Port expenses.

My predecessor left the Port in mid-2007; the position was vacant until May 2008. During the 2008 session, another manager was assigned state government relations only for that session. Because of these circumstances, I believe our direct contact with legislators and staff on state issues was minimal from mid-2007 until the end of 2008.

Our irregular reporting during the period in question results in part from the Port's employee transition in each of the three roles involved with our L-5 reports: the department director (departed 2006), the state government relations manager (departed 2007) and the administrative assistant (departed 2006). The transitions impacted our ability to ensure regular reporting. Unfortunately, the incorrect reporting had not been flagged internally or by the PDC. Reporting lapsed entirely after first quarter 2006, which meant the new administrative assistant never prepared any new L-5 reports or had any involvement with the preparation of the earlier reports. Reporting requirements were not included in transition orientations for any of the positions. In 2008, when I requested any filing relating to PDC reporting, the assistant was not familiar with any department efforts and did not locate any materials, reinforcing the incorrect assumption that there was no additional filing required. This reflected the problems with the number of transitions in the department, as well as my own lapse in not contacting the PDC to confirm our requirements.

When discussing this with Mr. Young, he clarified that the L-5 does not have a compliance process built in, since the report is only triggered by reportable expenses being incurred by the agency. This was very helpful to learn, as we have significant experience with F-1 filings by our commissioners. The F-1 has a robust notification, reminder and compliance process for those required to file. I relied on my familiarity with F-1 and L-2s and did not realize we had an omission by not filing an L-5.

Since this was brought to my attention, I have taken several steps to ensure the Port meets all filing requirements going forward, including: apprising the senior managers and Port general counsel of our reporting oversight; scheduling an annual review as part of our legislative session preparation to go over compliance requirements; including a memo in the department staff transition notebook with a copy of the filing requirements handbook from the PDC; and completing all past-due reports as well as reports due for fourth quarter of 2010. Reporting deadlines have been noted on my calendar and compliance performance has been included in the annual performance review for the state government relations manager position.

I hope this additional information and background helps clarify the Port's lapse in filing, but also our firm intent going forward to address the lapse and provide accurate transparent reporting to the PDC.
