

This revised complaint is filed against a Political Action Committee called New Americans for Accountable Government. The contact person is Conrad Lee. This was a single year PAC for 2010.

1. On October 14, 2011 New Americans for Accountable Government received a contribution for \$1,500 from a political committee called "Friends of Conrad Lee". This is Mr. Lee's campaign committee for his reelection to the Bellevue City Council. Contributions to PAC's from candidates committees are not allowed.
2. New Americans for Accountable Government failed to file a C-4 for the period of October 26, 2010 to November 30, 2010 when they apparently made expenditures. (The C-4 for the period of October 12, 2011 to October 25, 2010 lists to date expenditures on line 17 as \$2,973.91 and line 10 on the C-4 for the period of December 1, 2010 to December 31, 2010 line 10 lists previous in-kind expenditures as \$6,655.39).
3. New Americans for Accountable Government Complaint made illegal in-kind contributions in excess of the \$800 limit for the general election of 2010 to the following candidates:
 - a. Greg Bennett who was a candidate for the Washington State Senate in 2010 in the 48th District.
 - b. Phil Wilson who was a candidate for the Washington State House of representatives in 2010 in the 48th District.
 - c. Steve Litzow who was a candidate for the Washington State Senate in 2010 in the 41st District.
 - d. Peter Dunbar who was a candidate for the Washington State House of Representatives in the 41st District.
