

Dear Ms. Doyle:

The Attorney General's Office has received a complaint from Mr. Kevin Cairns concerning actions of the 45th Legislative District Democrats. The complaint alleges violations of the campaign finance disclosure law, RCW 42.17 (sic) and is attached. The letter was received by my office on Friday, October 19, 2012.

As is customary with this type of complaint, we are referring the complaint to your agency for review and possible investigation. We will await the results of that review and any action from the Commission before proceeding further. In the event the Commission determines that it is appropriate to schedule an administrative hearing related to any allegations against either entity, please advise. Otherwise, I would request the Commission's recommendation with how to proceed, with any report of investigation that may be completed, be forwarded to the Attorney General when complete.

I have been assigned the file in our office. I am available to answer any legal questions you may have during the course of your review or investigation. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to call me at (360) 753-0543.

Dear Attorney General McKenna, Ms. Dalton, and Prosecutor Satterberg:

This letter – also known as a 45-day letter – is to notify you of my request to commence a civil action pursuant to RCW 42.17 in the name of the State of Washington against the 45th Legislative District Democrats for multiple violations of the Public Disclosure Act, including failure to timely file C3 Reports, failure to file timely C4 Reports and failure to file required accelerating reporting for both the 2012 Primary and General Elections.

By the terms of the Public Disclosure Commission’s mission statement:

“The Public Disclosure Commission was created and empowered by Initiative of the People to provide timely and meaningful public access to accurate information about the financing of political campaigns, lobbyist expenditures, and the financial affairs of public officials and candidates, and to ensure compliance with and equitable enforcement of Washington’s disclosure and campaign finance laws.”

Washington State citizens have absolute right to know the source of contributions and the expenditures being made to influence the direction of their vote.

The 45th District Democrats have made multiple contributions to 45th District Democratic candidate Roger Goodman without filing any C3 information on the source of those contributions.

The following contributions have been reported by candidate Roger Goodman's campaign for state representative:

<i>45th District Democrats</i>	<i>7/22/2012</i>	<i>\$4500 (Primary)</i>
<i>45th District Democrats</i>	<i>10/5/2012</i>	<i>\$4000 (General)</i>
<i>45th District Democrats</i>	<i>10/15/2012</i>	<i>\$13500 (General)</i>

In reviewing the information available to the public via the Public Disclosure Commission's website, the last filing by the 45th District was a C3 Report on 7/6/2012 (for which no C4 Report was ever filed).

Clearly, the 45th District Democrats are deliberately concealing both the sources of major contributions and the expenditure of same. Not just once, but a number of times. They have also failed to file expenditure reports both for these contributions and contributions received prior, as required by law.

An investigation into the source of these contributions and the failure to file, in any form, is immediately imperative. Concurrently, there must also be an investigation into the conspiracy that might stand behind it.

There are also additional questions about the complicity of candidate Roger Goodman in these contributions as they constitute a significant portion of the total revenue-to-date into his campaign. Given the significance, I wish to question candidate Goodman, under penalty of perjury, about his involvement in the solicitation and acceptance of these illegal contributions.


Given the size and scope of this potential conspiracy, I believe the felony penalty provisions of state campaign laws must be applied in order to prevent any other organization from so blatantly violating reporting requirements.



Dear Mr. Stutzman:

The 45th District Democrats deeply regrets its lack in timely filing its C3, C4, and accelerated reports. The lapse in its reporting is due to oversight caused by the inexperience of its recently elected Treasurer and its new Chair as well as recent organizational changes. Simply put, the organization's membership failed to notice it was not compliant. This is not a pardonable excuse, but it is a valid and a complete explanation. And it must be noted that as soon as the oversight of its failure to report was discovered, the organization's leadership took immediate action to remedy the mistake.

There is simply no merit to the House Republican Campaign Committee's claim that there was a conspiratorial intent to hide the source of the 45th District Democrats' contributors or its expenditures. That the HROC dispensed a press release announcing the 45th District Democrats' oversight before the PDC received its Complaint, and during the General Election, is telling; the HROC's strong accusations are essentially making a politically motivated mountain out of an accidental molehill.

The 45th District Democrats has never been the subject of a PDC Complaint, nor has its current or immediate past Treasurer. It is for that reason that the 45th District Democrats requests the PDC view this matter through equitable lenses and favor a lenient outcome. And specifically, it requests that the PDC conclude its investigation by dismissing this Complaint and by recommending that the Attorney General take no further action.

I. Background

The 45th District Democrats coordinates democratic activities throughout Washington's 45th Legislative District. It makes endorsements, organizes events and directs resources to support local, state and national candidates. The group is truly grassroots: it is run entirely by unpaid, well-intended volunteers; it is not run by professionally trained campaign staff members who are paid for their time and is not afforded the use of paid consultants who can manage its PDC compliance. The 45th District Democrats' current mailing address is PO Box 2784 Redmond, Washington 98073.

The 45th District Democrats' current Treasurer is Eric Laliberte (425-218-2135) and the organization's immediate past Treasurer, who resigned in April 2012, is Ian Jacobson (206-595-3013). The organization's current Chair, and the person who prepared this response with input, review, and verification from its executive board, is Trent Latta (206-380-7446).

The House Republican Organizational Committee is the official campaign arm of the Washington State House Republican Caucus. Its mailing address is PO Box 7222 Olympia, Washington 98507 and its phone number is (360) 357-4762. Kevin Carns, the individual who filed this Complaint, is the HROC's paid Political Director.

II. Allegations in Complaint

In its October 22, 2012 Complaint, the HROC alleges that the 45th District Democrats: (1) failed to timely file its C3 Reports; (2) failed to timely file its C4 Reports; and (3) failed to timely file its 2012 Primary and General Election accelerated reports. These alleged violations, the HRCO claims, run afoul of the PDC's Mission Statement, which provides in part that the PDC render "equitable enforcement of Washington's disclosure and campaign finance laws." Notably, the HROC's allegations stem only from the timeliness of the 45th District Democrats' reporting.

The HROC further maintains that this lack of timely reporting demonstrates a deliberate attempt by the 45th District Democrats to conceal the source of its contributions and to hide the identity of its expenditures. This allegation implies, according to HROC, that an underlying conspiracy exists between the 45th District Democrats and political candidates to violate campaign finance laws.

III. Specific Response to Allegations

There was, admittedly, an extended lapse in the 45th District Democrats' PDC reporting. From approximately July 6, 2012, until October 23, 2012, the 45th District Democrats did not file its C3, C4, and accelerated reports as required. But equally true is the fact that, as soon as

the organization's leadership discovered its oversight, the problems were remedied. There is simply no merit to the HROC's claim that the 45th District Democrats intentionally violated any campaign finance laws as part of a larger conspiracy to conceal the source of its contributions or the recipients of its expenditures.

A. The 45th District Democrats' lapse in reporting was due to fluctuating organizational changes and to a regrettable oversight caused by the inexperience of its Treasurer.

There are two predominate reasons for the 45th District Democrats' lapse in its PDC reporting: (1) organizational changes and (2) oversight caused by inexperience. Its mistake is not due to any intentional or conspiratorial cover-up as the HROC proposes.

The 2011 redistricting that took effect in January of this year left the 45th District Democrats ruffled and without the practiced leadership it had in years past. Redistricting left several of the 45th District Democrats' executive board positions vacant, including, most importantly, its Chair position.

As a result, I volunteered and I assumed the role of Chair in January 2012. But I accepted the organization's Chair position without a comprehensive understanding of public disclosure requirements. Given that, to satisfy the 45th District Democrats' PDC filing requirements, I placed a great deal of confidence in the organization's Treasurer, whose responsibility, according to its Bylaws, is to ensure "adherence to the requirements of the Public Disclosure Commission."

In addition, the organization's immediate past Treasurer, Ian Jacobson, was running a First Congressional District Campaign during the first six months of 2012; that consumed most Mr. Jacobson's time. Accordingly, when Mr. Jacobson resigned in April 2012, Eric Laliberte was elected to fill the Treasurer role. And when Mr. Laliberte accepted the Treasurer position, he simply did not comprehend the breadth of reporting needed from him to satisfy the organization's filing obligations. That important change and resulting disconnect left the 45th District Democrats without the continuity needed from its Treasurer position to ensure timely reporting.

Accordingly, it is true that the 45th District Democrats, for some time, was not compliant in its PDC reporting. Nonetheless, the lapse was only temporary and as soon as the gravity of the mistake was comprehended, the 45th District Democrats' leadership took immediate action to resolve the issue.

B. There is no merit to the HROC's claim that the 45th District Democrats intended to conceal the source of its contributors or expenditures.

The HROC's allegation that the 45th District Democrats' lapse in reporting evidences an intent to hide the source of contributions or expenditures is without merit. The only evidence cited by the HROC for this serious allegation is the 45th District Democrats' failure to timely report, which has now been remedied. The disclosures now made by the 45th District Democrats, though untimely, speak for themselves. And relevant information about the 45th District Democrats expenses and contributions is now readily available to the public in advance of the November 6, 2012 General Election.

The only reason the lapse in the 45th District Democrats' reporting resumed when they did – after the HROC made its Complaint – is because *that* is when the organization discovered its Treasurer had not been reporting its contributions and expenditures. Had the 45th District Democrats realized sooner its lack of timely reporting – before the HROC filed a Complaint – then it would have remedied the mistake then.

Again, given the gravity of the HROC's allegations, it is worth emphasizing again: the 45th District Democrats' lapse in reporting was a terribly regrettable oversight; its late reporting is not evidence of any larger scheme to conceal campaign money. The 45th District Democrats simply had nothing to hide and it had nothing to gain by failing to timely file its C3 and C4 reports. In light of the organization's subsequent disclosures there is no basis whatsoever for the HROC's allegations, and without more, the claims must be disregarded.

C. When its mistakes were realized, the 45th District Democrats immediately took action to remedy the problems by filing its C3, C4, and accelerated reports; the organization is now, to the best of its knowledge, in compliance with its PDC reporting obligations.

Again, it is true that, due to its oversight, the 45th District Democrats fell behind on its reporting. But it is equally true that as soon as the mistake became apparent, the situation was immediately addressed.

On Monday, October 22, 2012, a local reporter contacted me about a press release issued by the HROC. The reporter sent me the press release, which described the pending 45-Day Letter it filed with the State's Attorney General's Office and with the King County Prosecutor's Office. I had not yet received the HROC Complaint. Although the press release did not list many specifics, I nonetheless took action to investigate the issues posed by the HROC. I contacted the organization's Treasurer and I solicited the help of senior leadership and, in doing so, I discovered that the 45th District Democrats had not timely filed its reports.

Within 24 hours of receiving that initial press release, the 45th District Democrats had started filing its missing C3, C4, and accelerated reports. Those reports accurately described the source of contributions it had received and also accurately described the beneficiaries of expenditures the organization had made. And as of the date of this letter, the 45th District Democrats, to the best of its knowledge, is current on its reporting obligations.

This fact – that the 45th District Democrats, without delay, immediately acted to remedy its lapse in reporting – warrants the PDC’s utilizing the same equitable considerations written in its Mission Statement cited by the HROC when evaluating this Complaint. It also defeats any claims by the HROC that the 45th District Democrats actively concealed its contributions and expenditures; indeed, all information about which the HROC previously complained is now publically available. This is not a situation in which the organization refused to comply with its reporting requirements, or otherwise deliberately defied campaign finance laws. Rather, this was merely a first-time mistake made by an inexperienced Treasurer and a distracted volunteer leadership.

In addition, this is the first time a Complaint has been filed against the 45th District Democrats and Mr. Laliberte has never before been the subject of a PDC Complaint. In that regard, the 45th District Democrats notes that Revised Code of Washington section 42.17A.755, which proscribes the procedure for rendering penalties for reporting violations, permits leniency for first-time violators: “The commission has the authority to waive a fine for a first-time violation.” (Subsection (5).)

D. The 45th District Democrats deeply regrets its reporting mistakes and is implementing new measures to ensure ongoing PDC reporting compliance.

The 45th District Democrats’ entire executive board is aware of this situation, is involved in this matter, and is now ensuring future compliance. With the help of the organization’s more seasoned leadership, it is doing everything it can without any further delay to maintain its PDC compliance. One of the 45th District Democrats professed values is to foster “Open and respectful discussions and fair elections.” It is with deep regret, therefore, that the 45th District Democrats lapsed in its compliance with the PDC’s reporting regulations.

IV. Conclusion

The 45th District Democrats understands the serious nature of its lack of timely reporting. The organization had an obligation. It was not met. And its leadership is regrouping to ensure this mistake never happens again. Any suggestion by the HROC that the 45th District Democrats’ failure to timely report evidences a deliberate attempt to hide the source of contributions or a conspiracy with specific candidates is an untrue and potentially politically

motivated attack. It is notable that now, even after the 45th District Democrats have remedied its unfortunate mistake, supporters of one of the HROC's candidates continues to call voters claiming that a democratic candidate in the 45th Legislative District accepted illegal contributions. Not unreported contributions. Illegal contributions. Such may be the unfortunate nature of a political campaign, but the PDC should not be drawn in by the HROC's attempt to turn a reporting error, even a serious one, into a political windfall.

Again, the organization cannot stress enough the regret felt from its mistake. The gravity of the lapse in reporting is, and will continue to be, met with an equal measure of correction. The PDC should take the 45th District Democrats' lapse in reporting only for what it is: a serious error by a transitioning and inexperienced leadership. The PDC should, therefore, dismiss this Complaint and recommend that the Attorney General take no further action.
