Report of Investigation

**I.**

**Background and Allegations**

- 1.1 On July 3, 2012, Matthew Tomaskin filed a Candidate Registration (C-1 report) with the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC), declaring his candidacy for State Representative in the 14<sup>th</sup> Legislative District, position #2 in 2012. **See Exhibit 1.** The C-1 report disclosed that Mr. Tomaskin selected the Full Reporting option indicating his campaign would file frequent, detailed reports of contribution and expenditure activities. The C-1 report listed Asa Washines as the campaign treasurer.
- 1.2 On October 16, 2012, Matthew Tomaskin filed an amended C-1 report indicating that he was changing reporting options from the Full Reporting option to the Mini Reporting option.
- 1.3 On October 22, 2012, the Tomaskin campaign filed a Cash Receipts Monetary Contributions report (C-3 report), disclosing the receipt of three contributions in excess of \$500, the Mini Reporting limit for a contribution from a single source. Therefore, the Tomaskin campaign was not eligible to move from the Full Reporting option to the Mini Reporting option.
- 1.4 Mr. Tomaskin had previously been a candidate for public office in 2011, when he ran for a Yakima County Freeholder position.
- 1.5 On October 15, 2012, Max Golloday filed a complaint with the PDC alleging that Mr. Tomaskin's 2012 campaign for State Representative failed to file the required contribution and expenditure reports disclosing its campaign activities.

## II. Allegations

- 2.1 Specifically, Mr. Golloday's complaint alleged that the Tomaskin campaign violated RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 by failing to file Campaign Summary Receipts & Expenditures reports (C-4 reports), and by failing to timely file C-3 reports during the 2012 election. **See Exhibit 2.**

## III. Findings

- 3.1 Under the Full Reporting option, candidates that appeared only on the August 7, 2012 primary election ballot, and the November 6, 2012, general election ballot, were required to file C-3 and C-4 reports as follows:
- Weekly C-3 reports were required to be filed every Monday beginning four months prior to the election, disclosing contributions received and deposited for the previous five business days;
  - A 21-day pre-primary election C-4 report was required to be filed on July 17, 2012, covering the period June 1 through July 16, 2012;
  - A 7-day pre-primary election C-4 report was required to be filed on July 31, 2012, covering the period July 17 through July 30, 2012;
  - A post-primary election C-4 report was required to be filed on September 10, 2012, covering the period July 31 through August 31, 2012;
  - A 21-day pre-general election C-4 report was required to be filed on October 16, 2012, covering the period September 1 through October 15, 2012;
  - A 7-day pre-general election C-4 report was required to be filed on October 30, 2012, covering the period October 16 through October 29, 2012;
  - A post-general election C-4 report was required to be filed no later than December 10, 2012, covering the period October 30 through November 30, 2012.

### **Failure to report campaign contribution and expenditure activities**

#### Failure to File C-4 Reports disclosing campaign expenditures:

- 3.1 No C-4 reports were filed during the 2012 Tomaskin campaign (referred to as the campaign).
- 3.2 On September 9, 2013, Asa Washines, treasurer for the campaign transmitted an email to PDC staff concerning the campaign's contributions and expenditures. **See Exhibit #3.** He attached two spreadsheets indicating that during the course of the election cycle the campaign received contributions totaling \$7,125, and made expenditures totaling \$7,125.
- 3.3 The \$7,125 in campaign expenditures included the following:

- \$3,664 for campaign signs;
- \$1,014 for campaign mailers and literature handouts;
- \$638 for several expenditures related to an October campaign event;
- \$500 for radio advertising;
- \$430 for campaign consulting;
- \$300 for political advertising paid to the 14<sup>th</sup> Legislative District Democrats;
- \$300 for gasoline for campaign volunteers to place and maintain campaign yard signs;
- \$150 for campaign supplies; and
- \$130 for a campaign webpage.

3.4 Staff re-created the C-4 reports in the table below that were required to be filed by the Tomaskin campaign during the 2012 election cycle, based on the spreadsheets provided by the campaign. The days late were computed from the due date to September 9, 2013, the date staff received the contribution and expenditure spreadsheets from the campaign.

- **21-day pre-primary election C-4 report:** The campaign failed to file its required 21-day pre-primary election C-4 report due July 17, 2012, covering the period June 1 through July 16, 2012. The 21-day pre-primary election C-4 report should have disclosed that the campaign made two bank deposits totaling \$2,400 during the reporting period, and an expenditure totaling \$500 for political advertising in the form of radio spots. The information was disclosed 419 days late.
- **7-day pre-primary election C-4 report:** The campaign failed to file its required 7-day pre-primary election C-4 report due July 31, 2012, covering the period July 17 through July 30, 2012. The C-4 report should have disclosed that the campaign received one \$25 contribution during the period, and made no expenditures.

- **Post primary election C-4 report:** The campaign failed to file its required post-primary election C-4 report due September 10, 2012, covering the period July 31 through August 31, 2012. The 2012 post-primary election C-4 report should have disclosed that the campaign received two contributions totaling \$1,900, and made two expenditures totaling \$1,825. The expenditures included a \$1,725 expenditure to Thompson Sign for campaign signs, and a \$100 expenditure for fuel to place and maintain the signs. The information was disclosed 364 days late.
- **21-day pre-general election C-4 report:** The campaign failed to file its required 21-day pre-general election C-4 report due October 16, 2012, covering the period September 1 through October 15, 2012. The 21-day pre-general election C-4 report should have disclosed that the campaign received four contributions totaling \$2,800, and made six expenditures totaling \$2,643. The six expenditures included: (1) printing additional campaign signs for \$1,939; (2) printing campaign literature for \$224; (3) design of a campaign website for \$130; (4) campaign supplies of \$150; and (5) fuel to place and maintain campaign signs for \$200. The information was disclosed 328 days late.
- **7-day pre-general election C-4 report:** The campaign failed to file its required 7-day pre-general election C-4 report due October 30, 2012, covering the period October 16 through October 29, 2012. The 7-day pre-general election C-4 report should have disclosed that the campaign received no contributions, and made six expenditures totaling \$1,728. The six expenditures included: (1) advertising paid to the 14<sup>th</sup> Legislative District Democrats for \$300; (2) campaign mailers for \$790; and (3) four expenditures for an October campaign event totaling \$638. The information was disclosed 314 days late.
- **Post-general election C-4 report:** The campaign failed to file its required post-general election C-4 report due December 10, 2012, covering the period October 30 through November 30, 2012. The post-general election C-4 report should have disclosed that the campaign received no contributions, and made one expenditures totaling \$430 for campaign consulting. The information was disclosed 273 days late.

**Failure to timely file C-3 reports**

3.5 On October 22, 2012, the campaign filed one C-3 report disclosing the receipt of 10 monetary contributions totaling \$4,550. **See Exhibit #4.** The C-3 report disclosed that the contributions had been received by the campaign during the period May 22 through September 25, 2012, and deposited on October 21, 2012.

3.6 Based on the spreadsheet received September 9, 2013 from the campaign listing its contributions and expenditures, the 10 contributions were filed between 14 and 140 days late, and eight days before the November 6, 2012 general election. The 10 contributions were as follows:

**Failure to file C-3 reports listing previously undisclosed campaign contributions**

3.7 The September 9, 2013 spreadsheet disclosed that the 2012 campaign received contributions totaling \$7,125, which included \$2,575 in previously unreported contributions. These three contributions were reported between 344 and 406 days late, and included the following:

3.8 Despite repeated requests from staff, no response was received from Mr. Tomaskin to the allegations listed in the complaint.

**IV.**  
**Scope**

4.1 PDC staff reviewed the complaint received from Max Golladay and filed against Matthew Tomaskin on October 15, 2012.

4.2 Staff reviewed the one C-3 report filed by the Matthew Tomaskin campaign on October 22, 2012.

4.3 PDC staff contacted Mr. Tomaskin on several occasions as noted below:

- November 9, 2012: Staff sent a letter to Mr. Tomaskin informing him of the complaint, and providing him an opportunity to respond to the allegations. No response was received.
- May 15, 2013: Staff sent Mr. Tomaskin a letter informing him that a formal investigation had been started, and requesting a written response to the allegations in the complaint.
- July 10, 2013: Staff left a telephone message for Mr. Tomaskin asking him to respond to the complaint.

- July 18, 2013: Staff sent a letter to Mr. Tomaskin requesting a response to the complaint.

#### V. Law

5.1 **RCW 42.17A.235 and .240** require candidates to file timely, accurate reports of contributions and expenditures, including in-kind contributions. Under the full reporting option, until five months before the general election, C-4 reports are required monthly when contributions or expenditures exceed \$200 since the last report. C-4 reports are also required 21 and 7 days before each election, and in the month following the election, regardless of the level of activity. Contribution deposits made during this same time period must be disclosed on the Monday following the date of deposit.
