I hereby acknowledge that as Pasco School District Superintendent, I authorized the use of public facilities to conduct two community surveys in the fall of 2011 and 2012 for the partial purpose of promoting a ballot proposition, violations of RCW 42.17.130 and RCW 42.17A.555.

In order to avoid the time and expense resulting from a Brief Adjudicative Proceeding (brief enforcement hearing) before the Commission, I have completed this Statement of Understanding, and enclosed a check or money order in the amount of \$100.

I understand that this will resolve all issues concerning the violations alleged in PDC staff's December 4, 2015 Notice of Administrative Charges in PDC Case No. 13-097, provided that a check or money order for \$100 and this signed Statement of Understanding are received by PDC staff prior to the scheduled brief enforcement hearing.

I further understand that the Commission will not hold a brief enforcement hearing regarding the alleged violations of RCW 42.17.130 and RCW 42.17A.555 as described above.
