My name is Adam Pope and I am a resident of Stevens County, Washington. I filed a complaint about the improper reporting practices of Candidate Brian Dansel, Committee to Elect Brian Dansel on October 25, 2013 asking the PDC to investigate Candidate Dansel. I have not heard anything from the PDC of their investigation.

As of October 30, 2013, Brian Dansel again failed to file his C4 by the 10/29 deadline. Why is this willful rule breaking allowed to continue without the PDC imposing sanctions? The public has a right to know where candidate Dansel's money is coming from.

I have received two Dansel campaign mailers and heard numerous radio ads, all paid for by the Committee to Elect Brian Dansel. These spots cost a lot of money, and Candidate Dansel's late filing and numbers do not add up.

Candidate Dansel's campaign is persistently neglecting to file reports to obfuscate the sources and expenditures of his campaign funds. As a sitting Ferry County Commissioner Candidate Dansel should be familiar with the PDC legal reporting requirements, and how to file timely and appropriate forms.

Thank you for your continued investigation into Candidate Brian Dansel's deplorable campaign finance reporting actions. I look forward to your investigation results and sanctions you impose on this critical public issue prior to next week's election deadline.


