13 **I. INTRODUCTION**

14 This matter was heard by the Washington State Public Disclosure Commission  
15 (Commission) on October 25, 2018, at the Public Disclosure Commission Office, 711 Capitol  
16 Way, Room 206, Olympia, Washington 98504. The hearing was held pursuant to Chapter 34.05  
17 RCW, Chapter 42.17A RCW, and Chapter 390-37 WAC.

18 Commissioners present were Anne Levinson, Commission Chair (presiding); David  
19 Ammons, Commission Vice-Chair; and Commissioner William Downing. Also present were  
20 Assistant Attorney General John S. Meader representing the Commission; Fox Blackhorn-  
21 Delph, PDC Compliance Coordinator; Tabatha Blacksmith, PDC Compliance Coordinator; and  
22 Assistant Attorney General Chad Standifer on behalf of PDC Staff. Respondent Travis  
23 McGregor did not participate. The proceeding was open to the public and recorded.

24 The Commissioners had before them the following materials:

- 25 • Enforcement Hearing Memorandum prepared by PDC Compliance Coordinator Tabatha  
26 Blacksmith dated October 23, 2018;

- 1 • Freshdesk ticket log dated August 7, 2018 describing the initial complaint;
- 2 • Email sent by PDC Staff to Respondent regarding the missing Personal Financial Affairs
- 3 Statement (F-1 report), dated August 17, 2018, and providing notice of the Brief
- 4 Adjudicative Proceeding on September 24, 2018;
- 5 • Email to Respondent dated October 5, 2018, notifying him of the outcome of the Brief
- 6 Adjudicative Proceeding held September 24, 2018;
- 7 • Email from Respondent requesting an appeal of the Initial Order dated October 22, 2018;
- 8 • Email from PDC staff dated October 23, 2018, providing notice to the Respondent of the
- 9 Review Hearing on October 25, 2018.
- 10 • PDC Case No. 38748 cover letter and Order Imposing Fine against Respondent Travis
- 11 McGregor dated October 5, 2018;
- 12 • Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 report) filed on October 22, 2018, by Travis
- 13 McGregor for calendar year 2017.

14 The hearing concerned allegations that Respondent violated RCW 42.17A.700 by failing  
15 to file a Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 report) for calendar year 2017 no later than  
16 April 16, 2018.

17  
18 After reviewing the record, including the testimony by PDC Staff and the Respondent,  
19 the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law,  
20 and Final Order of the Commission be entered:

## 22 **II. FINDINGS OF FACT**

23 1. Respondent Travis McGregor is a newly elected Fire Commissioner for Lewis County  
24 Fire Protection District 6, whose term began January 1, 2018.

25 2. The Respondent was required to file an F-1 report disclosing financial activities in  
26

1 calendar year 2017 no later than April 16, 2018 and did not timely do so.

2 3. From April to June 2018, PDC staff sent seven e-mail reminders to the Respondent  
3 concerning the F-1 filing requirement.

4 4. On July 16, 2018, PDC staff sent a warning letter by U.S. Mail, concerning the  
5 Respondent's failure to file the F-1 report.

6 5. On August 16, 2018, PDC staff served Respondent Travis McGregor by U.S. Mail and  
7 e-mail with a hearing notice for a Brief Adjudicative Proceeding to be held on September 24,  
8 2018, concerning failure to file the F-1 report.

9 6. On September 24, 2018, a Brief Adjudicative Proceeding was held in which the  
10 Presiding Officer found Travis McGregor in violation of RCW 42.17A.700 for failing to file an  
11 F-1 report for calendar year 2017. The Respondent was assessed a \$250 penalty in accordance  
12 with WAC 390-37-143, the penalty schedule adopted by the Commission, which was payable  
13 within 30 days of the date of the Order.

14 7. An Initial Order was entered October 5, 2018.

15 8. On October 22, 2018, Respondent requested an appeal of the Initial Order and filed  
16 the missing F-1 report for calendar year 2017, which was due no later than April 16, 2018.

17 9. On October 23, 2018, e-mail notice was provided to the Respondent of the Initial Order  
18 and of the October 25, 2018, Review Hearing.

19 10. Respondent has no previous violations.  
20

### 21 **III. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

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23 1. The Commission has jurisdiction over this proceeding pursuant to Chapter 42.17A RCW,  
24 the State campaign finance and disclosure law; Chapter 34.05 RCW, the Administrative  
25 Procedure Act; and Title 390 WAC.  
26

1 2. RCW 42.17A.700 states in part: “After January 1st and before April 15th of each year,  
2 every elected official and every executive state officer shall file with the commission a statement  
3 of financial affairs for the preceding calendar year.”  
4

5 3. WAC 390-24-025 states in part: “Any person holding elected public office, except as  
6 exempted by the terms of RCW 42.17A.700, ... is required to file the statement of financial  
7 affairs if such person holds such public office between January 1 and April 15 of any year. Such  
8 report shall be for the preceding calendar year.”  
9

10 4. Respondent Travis McGregor violated RCW 42.17A.700 by failing to file the F-1 report  
11 for calendar year 2017 no later than April 16, 2018.  
12

#### 13 **IV. ORDER**

14 Based upon the Findings and Conclusions, the Commission orders that:  
15

16 1. The Initial Order is AMENDED and \$150 of the \$250 total civil penalty is suspended if  
17 the following conditions are met:

- 18 a. The non-suspended civil penalty of \$100 is paid within 30 days of the date  
19 of this order.
- 20 b. Respondent Travis McGregor files all required PDC reports in accordance  
21 with RCW 42.17A.755(4) and have no further violations of Chapter  
22 42.17A RCW or Title 390 WAC within four years of this order.  
23

24 2. In the event the Respondent fails to pay the \$100 civil penalty within 30 days of the date  
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1 of this Order, the entire amount shall become due without further action by the Commission.

3 The Executive Director is authorized to enter this Order on behalf of the Commission.
