Respondent.

I. BACKGROUND

- 1.1 John McCoy is the incumbent Democratic State Senator from the 38th Legislative District. He was appointed to the Senate in 2013 and was elected to a full, four-year term in 2014. Prior to serving in the Senate, John McCoy served in the legislature as a House member, first in the 10th Legislative District, during 2001 and 2002, and then in the 38th Legislative District from 2003 until his appointment to the Senate in 2013.
- 1.2 Richard Dean Ledford has served as Senator McCoy's treasurer during his entire time in the House and Senate. John McCoy has not previously been the subject of a complaint or enforcement action.
- 1.3 On August 22, 2016, Senator McCoy filed a Candidate Registration (PDC Form C-1) stating that he was a candidate for re-election in 2018. He will appear on the November 6, 2018 general election ballot.
- 1.4 On May 1, 2018, Justin Matheson, Executive Director of the Senate Republican Campaign Committee, filed a complaint alleging that Senator McCoy's 2018 reelection committee had failed to file the required contribution and expenditure reports following the 2014 election.

II. ALLEGATIONS IN COMPLAINT

2.1 On May 1, 2018, Justin Matheson, Executive Director of the Senate Republican Campaign Committee, filed a Citizen Action Notice under then-RCW 42.17A.765(4), providing notice to the Attorney General, the Snohomish County Prosecuting Attorney, and the Thurston County Prosecuting Attorney, that he had reason to believe John McCoy (Re-Elect John McCoy) 2018 Campaign had violated RCW 42.17A by failing to report contributions and expenditures from 2015-2018.

Mr. Matheson also filed his complaint with the Public Disclosure Commission. **(Exhibit 1)**

- 2.2 The complaint stated that it had come to the attention of the Senate Republican Campaign Committee that Senator McCoy, his campaign committee, "Re-Elect John McCoy" and his treasurer, Richard Dean Ledford, had "habitually and willfully committed frequent and multiple violations of RCW 42.17A." The complaint alleged that over a period of three years, Senator McCoy's campaign waited months, and sometimes years, to disclose nearly \$40,000 in campaign contributions. The complaint also stated that in some instances, the McCoy campaign failed to timely deposit campaign contributions.
- 2.3 Following its standard practice, PDC staff did not begin an assessment or investigation because the complaint was filed as a Citizen Action Notice under RCW 42.17A.765 with the Attorney General, the Snohomish County Prosecuting Attorney, and the Thurston County Prosecuting Attorney. After it became clear in July 2018 that the Attorney General would not be pursuing the allegations against the McCoy campaign, PDC staff began its assessment.

III. FINDINGS

- 3.1 On May 2, 2018, PDC staff provided a copy of the complaint to John McCoy, and asked for a response to the allegations by May 9, 2018 for the purpose of posting the response to the enforcement page of the PDC website.
- 3.2 In July 2018, following passage of ESHB 2938 during the 2018 legislative session, which changed the authority of the Attorney General to prosecute complaints filed under RCW 42.17A, the PDC assessed the complaint filed by Mr. Matheson, and on July 5, 2018, again requested a response to the allegations, by July 19, 2018. PDC staff also informed Senator McCoy of the changes to RCW 42.17A, and explained the impact of those changes on the complaint filed by Mr. Matheson.
- 3.3 On August 3, 2018, Justin Matheson filed a "10-day notice" under RCW 42.17A.775, based on the fact that the complaint had been in the possession of the PDC for more than 90 days. Mr. Matheson stated that he intended to commence a citizen's action within 10 days if the PDC had not taken action as described in RCW 42.17A.775, and as authorized under RCW 42.17A.755.
- 3.4 Upon receipt of the "10- day notice" from Mr. Matheson, PDC staff conducted a preliminary review and assessment of the complaint, and on August 3, 2018, opened a formal investigation. On August 9, 2018, staff held an Initial Hearing (Case Status Review Hearing), pursuant to RCW 42.17A.755, and WACs 390-37-060 and 390-37-071. By opening a formal investiation and holding a Case Status Review Hearing within 10 days of receiving the 10-day notice from Mr. Matheson, PDC staff took action as authorized under RCW 42.17A.755.

Response by Re-Elect John McCoy Campaign

- 3.5 On July 24, 2018, Richard Dean Ledford, treasurer for Senator John McCoy, responded to the complaint (Exhibit 2).
- 3.6 Mr. Ledford has been the treasurer for Senator McCoy since 2000, with no reporting or enforcement issues. Mr. Ledford stated that many of the reports cited in the complaint as late were voluntary reports, filed for months in which there was less than \$200 in reportable activity. For the reports that were required, and that were late, Mr. Ledford offered a lengthy explanation citing several medical and traumatic events in his life, and the life of his spouse. He also stated that his computer was corrupted with a virus, that he lost all campaign data from the PDC's ORCA software program, and that he experienced difficulty reinstating the missing information. The late reporting occurred following Senator McCoy's 2014 election, during 2015-2018.
- 3.7 Mr. Ledford stated he was hospitalized on October 8, 2014 for brain surgery, which included surgery, recovery, rehabilitation, and then home for more rehabilitation. He said he tried to maintain filing with the PDC during this time.
- 3.8 Mr. Ledford explained that in July 2016, he received a call from someone he believed to be a computer tech person, telling him his computer had a technical problem, and that he needed to call a number for assistance. He discovered it was a fraudulent call, and by calling the number he was given and following the directions he received, his computer was infected with a computer virus, became frozen, and would not function properly. He then took his computer to a reputable repair business, and while the business was conducting the needed work, the technician mistakenly deleted his PDC ORCA software and data set.
- 3.9 On August 22, 2016, Senator McCoy hand-delivered to the PDC a Candidate Registration (Form C-1) for his 2018 re-election campaign, something that would normally have been handled by Mr. Ledford on behalf of the campaign.
- 3.10 Because of the computer virus, Mr. Ledford installed a new copy of the ORCA software on his computer, and attempted to re-enter the entire 2018 campaign, starting with January 1, 2015. However, he was unable to enter 2018 campaign data because he mistakenly selected 2017 instead of 2018 as the election year. Mr. Ledford contacted PDC Filer Assistance Specialist Jennifer Hansen on several occasions in 2016, and then again in 2018, for help in filing the missing information.
- 3.11 Mr. Ledford described how personal issues contributed to his late reporting. He stated that his spouse was recovering from breast cancer surgery, and had to stop driving, which required him to drive her to numerous doctor and hospital visits. He said she developed other physical problems that required treatments from several specialists. He said his spouse was admitted to the hospital in 2016 with heart problems.
- 3.12 Mr. Ledford described that in 2017, he and his spouse were in an automobile accident that sent his spouse to the hospital, and required many doctor visits for him

and his spouse. He said his spouse was hospitalized in July and December 2017 with pneumonia, and developed other physical ailments. He said that during this time, he became the primary care giver for his spouse. Mr. Ledford stated that in 2018, his spouse developed additional physical problems, including two heart attacks.

3.13 Mr. Ledford apologized for not maintaining the required campaign reporting for Senator McCoy.

Senator John McCoy

- 3.14 Senator McCoy acknowledged being aware of Mr. Ledford's and his spouse's medical issues. He said he was not campaigning during that time and assumed everything was up to date because he did not expect contributions to be coming in. He said he did not expect filing a manual C-1 would contribute to the campaign's reporting problems. Senator McCoy said Mr. Ledford provided an accurate description of what happened, and he stands by Mr. Ledford's account, and takes full responsibility for what happened.
- 3.15 Senator McCoy stated that until these reporting problems, Mr. Ledford has always been on time over the previous 16 years, noting that Mr. Ledford has communicated frequently with the PDC about anything and everything. He said it was for this reason that he did not think anything was amiss. He said while Mr. Ledford was recuperating, he thought about replacing him, but wanted Mr. Ledford to tell him when it was time. He said Mr. Ledford recently advised him it was time, and he has taken steps to set this in motion.

John McCoy (Re-Elect John McCoy) 2018 Campaign C-3 Reports

- 3.16 Candidates and political committees are required to disclose contributions received on PDC form C-3. A review of the C-3 reports filed by Mr. Ledford during the period 2015-2018 revealed that 18 reports were filed between 80 and 842 days late, with late-reported contributions totaling \$38,926. Nearly all contributions were from organizations and entities. Total days late for the 18 reports were 7,789. The late-reported contributions were from 60 contributors. (Exhibits 3 & 4)
- 3.17 In addition, contributions totaling \$17,700 were not deposited within five business days of receipt, as required by RCW 42.17A.220. These contributions were deposited from 1 to 66 days late.

John McCoy (Re-Elect John McCoy) 2018 Campaign C-4 Reports

- 3.18 Candidates and political committees are required to summarize contributions from C-3 reports, and list expenditures, on PDC form C-4. The report is not required in months where contributions or expenditures do not exceed \$200, until the cumulative contributions or expenditures since the last C-4 report exceed \$200.
- 3.19 A review of C-4 reports filed by Mr. Ledford during the period 2015-2018 revealed that 15 C-4 reports were filed a total of 6,916 days late, with individual

reports filed from 58 to 1,062 days late. Six of the 15 late-filed C-4 reports were required because small expenditures from previous months had reached an aggregate of over \$200, and nine of the late-filed reports were required because campaign activity in that month exceeded \$200. (Exhibits 5 & 6)

- 3.20 The chart in Exhibit 5 lists the C-4 reports for the period January 1, 2015 to July 30, 2018, whether filed timely or late. While the chart shows expenditures totaling \$39,832, late-reported expenditures during this period totaled \$5,089.
- 3.21 While the chart in Exhibit 5 shows total receipts of \$69,057, late-reported contributions, as described in Exhibit 3, were \$38,926.

IV. SCOPE

- 4.1 PDC staff reviewed the following documents:
 - 1. A complaint filed against John McCoy, (Re-Elect McCoy) 2018 Campaign, received from Justin Matheson, Executive Director, Senate Republican Campaign Committee, on May 1, 2018.
 - 2. A response to the complaint submitted by Richard Dean Ledford, on behalf of Senator McCoy, on July 24, 2018.
 - 3. C-3 reports of contributions, and C-4 reports of contributions and expenditures, filed by Richard Dean Ledford on behalf of John McCoy (Re-Elect John McCoy) 2018 Campaign, for 2015-2018.
 - 4. Reviewed results of Initial Hearing (Case Status Review Hearing) held August 9, 2018.

V. LAW

RCW 42.17A.235 and RCW 42.17A.240 require candidates to file timely, accurate reports of contributions and expenditures. Under the full reporting option, until five months before the general election, C-3 and C-4 reports are required monthly when contributions or expenditures exceed \$200 since the last report.

RCW 42.17A.220 states that all monetary contributions received by a candidate or political committee shall be deposited by candidates, political committee members, paid staff, or treasurers in a depository in an account established and designated for that purpose. Such deposits shall be made within five business days of receipt of the contribution.

Senate Republican Campaign Committee

To Whom It May Concern --

It has come to our attention that State Senator John McCoy, his campaign committee "Re-Elect John McCoy", and his treasurer Richard Ledford, have habitually and willfully committed frequent and multiple violations of RCW 42.17A. Additionally, we have reason to believe that other violations of this chapter have occurred beyond what has been identified below.

Summary of Violations

State law requires that candidates and committees file frequent, accurate, reports of contributions, expenditures, in-kind contributions, debt, pledges, and loans (C3s and C4s).

Unfortunately, the 2018 Senate re-election campaign for John McCoy has failed to abide by this requirement.

Over a period of 3 years, McCoy waited months and sometimes years to disclose nearly \$40,000 that he had received in campaign contributions from unions, corporations, and other special interest groups. In many instances, McCoy's campaign failed to timely deposit campaign contributions it had received, in violation of state law. Additionally, he failed to disclose numerous expenditures in a timely basis.

See Attachment A (Late Filed Reports) and Attachment B (Individual Late Reported Contributions).

A few points to note:

- McCoy accepted tens of thousands of dollars from unions, corporations, and other special interest groups that went undisclosed for years.
- Many contributions should have been disclosed in advance of the 2016, 2017, and 2018 legislative sessions, but were not disclosed until after the 2018 session.
- McCoy served on the committee (State Governmental Operations) that has oversight and subject matter jurisdiction over the Public Disclosure Commission and campaign finance regulations.
- John McCoy has been an elected official and candidate (subject to PDC disclosure requirements) from 2002 to 2018, over 16 years.
- In total, McCoy late reported 79 individual contributions valued at \$39,276.93. Cumulatively, the individual contributions were reported 25916 days late.

Conclusion

RCW 42.17A.001 states that:

"...political campaign and lobbying contributions and expenditures be fully disclosed to the public and that secrecy is to be avoided..."

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"...the public's right to know of the financing of political campaigns and lobbying and the financial affairs of elected officials and candidates far outweighs any right that these matters remain secret and private..."

"...the people have the right to expect from their elected representatives at all levels of government the utmost of integrity, honesty, and fairness in their dealings..."

Given the sheer volume of undisclosed and late-reported contributions received by Senator McCoy over the last 3 years, this case must be referred to the Attorney General's office for prosecution.

The maximum penalty the Public Disclosure Commission is able to levy in this case is insufficient to address the severity of the violation. Additionally, given the speed of the PDC's enforcement process, it is unlikely that they would be able to adjudicate this issue prior to the 2018 elections being held.

Dear Mr. Blackhorn;

I'm writing this letter in response to the complaint from Justin Matheson on 5/1/2018 for violation of RCW 42.17A.235. The response was initially due by May 9, 2018 but due to an incorrect email address, and to further complicate a revised response date of 7/19/2018 I am asking for a date of 7/26/2018 or sooner.

I reviewed Attachment A & B, and there were 30 reports that may be voluntary per RCW 42.17A.235. The remaining reports I will attempt to provide a valid reporting date. But first I would adventure into WAC 390-37-061. There comes times in our life that occur beyond our control, and I will commence with me being hospitalized for brain surgery (Subdural Hematoma), Oct 8, 2014. I was not aware of what took place in my life until I was in recovery, and from there to rehab, and then home care for more rehab. Needless to say I tried to maintain filing with PDC, and I guess one might say one problem led to another.

The added problem was receiving a call from a computer tech telling me I had a technical problem and too call this number only to find out it was a bogus call and it locked up my PC and all I could do was take it in Tech Data Services, a Tulalip operation. After getting it back I found out they dumped my ORCA program. Things didn't get any better but I kept trying to keep the files on track.

Fox, I'm going to switch tracks as my spouse,(Ella), has been with me for 59 years, and we have gone through a lot together over these years. She is a breast cancer survivor of 20 years, and at that time she had to give up driving due to the pain she encountered after a double mastectomy. So that left me to transport her to various places, and in the past 4 years there have been numerous doctor, and hospital visits. In 2014 she developed an eating disorder where the food she attempted to consume did not taste good. We went to so many doctors, and specialist with negative results. It is devastating for her to be in that situation as she was a great cook, and still is. Over the years her taste buds have diminished but she forces herself to eat, and over the past few months the taste of water has been affected as well as other liquids, again she forces herself to drink knowing her kidneys might be affected. We have tried every eating venues, and at the beginning we sorta joked about it by asking each other, where do you want to go, and what do you want to eat? But now it has become somewhat depressing for me, and frustrating for both of us. Yes she has lost a lot of weight. June, 2016 she was admitted to Providence Hospital with chest pains and they inserted two stents, in Dec, 2016, she was again admitted to the hospital with chest pains, and they inserted new stents to replace ones that had collasped.

March 10, 2017 we were hit nearly head-on, totalled out our vehicle and sent Ella to the hospital with painful ribs, and I went to the walk-in clinic for precautionary exam for back pains, sore wrist and elbow. Within the next day or two my arm & hand swelled up and my shoulder ached. I also developed Carpul Tunnel in the left hand but have had to put off surgery since it would be a 6 week recovery, and being the only driver in the home, and amongst other chores I encountered. I will continue to have the tingling sensation until I find time to have surgery. In the mean time that tingling sensation wakes me up early morning, etc,etc..

Returning to Ella's health problems, She was hospitalized with pneumonia in July & Dec, of 2017. In Aug, 2017, Ella developed extreme weakness and exhaustion, and was referred to Interventional Radiologist for Bone Marrow Biopsy. Tests revealed she has low red blood count causing her to have cold extremities. They have done two blood transfusions with negative results, and have started Pro Crit injections. In the meantime Ella has continue her weak condition. So during her poor health I have become her care giver which allows me to live up to our wedding vows, the part that says"in Sickness and in Health". We pray that she will one day get back her energy and her health. This year, 2018 has not been any better. Early this year she developed a cough, sore throat, and a lot of mucus, and for her the continued coughing to bring up the crude only irritated the throat and her voice box. Another doctor appointment this one with ENT, and that wasn't pleasant, having him insert a camera tube into her nostril to get a picture of his findings, a growth on her voice box, and a new prescription of antibiotics. Cleared up the growth but another tube insertion to check the throat. Each time only aggravated the sore throat, cough still remained, new prescription, magic mouthwash. Two more appointments, but Ella developed laryngitis, his recommendation, speech therapist come to the home for treatment. Speech Therapist were great and improved the laryngitis, but the cough remained. Another chapter: Possible with all the stress, Ella had two heart attacks, called EMT, but they were reluctant to transport her to ER. Finally they got her to the ER, and after all their test the coronary doctor scheduled her for surgery the next day to insert new stents, four, after further camera findings. We thought the stents would improve the red blood count but it only fixed the heart condition. I previously mentioned the two blood transfusions, and the PRO CRIT injections. Cough, cough, is what I hear most of the night. Have not been able to combat that condition. Not sure where we turn to next. Very depressing, not being able to help, and it brings tears to my eyes.

I try to stay positive for a number of reasons, and remain healthy to take care of my LOVE, "death do us part". I'm sorry for what I have livid on you. I'm also sorry that I have brought shame to Senator John McCoy by not maintaining his campaign report per RCW 42.17A.

Fox, I will continue to work on the Attachment B, and should have it ready today. Maybe I went about it all wrong in trying to correct some C 3 and C 4 records, that is why the reporting period are 3/29/2018 thru 3/31/2018, I may have amended incorrectly. Thanks for your utmost consideration in this matter.
