In response to the Public Disclosure Commission Complaint filed on April 20th, 2018 by Mary D. Brown against the Pierce County Republican Party and the allegation of a violation of RCW 42.17A.260, the Pierce County Republican Party refutes the allegation and provides the following statement of facts to the contrary.

The artwork for the postcard was modified and approved by the Pierce County Republican Party Chair.

The Post Card was paid for by the Pierce County Republican Party.

The Mailing list, provided by the Pierce County Republican Party was sent to the vendor and edited for duplicates by the Pierce County Republican Party.

The postage for the mailer was paid for by the Pierce County Republican Party.

These expenses were filed appropriately on a C6 on 4/17/2018. In abundance of caution (and to err on the side of transparency) the expenses will also be reported as an in-kind/IE expense on our May 10, 2018 C-4.

All donations to the Party have been filed and/or will be filed as required through election and PDC rules in a timely fashion.
