Dear Jeff Harvey:

After conducting a preliminary review and assessment of a complaint filed August 2, 2018 by Sarah Norman-Elbaum against Citizens for Progress Enterprise Washington, PDC staff opened a formal investigation on October 17, 2019, and held an Initial Hearing (Case Status Review Hearing) on October 19, 2018, pursuant to RCW 42.17A.755, and WACs 390-37-060 and 390-37-071.

At the hearing it was noted that RCW 42.17A.755 provides PDC staff with additional tools to resolve complaints through the use of alternatives to non-compliance, and I am encouraging you to work with staff on resolving this matter.

If PDC staff does not receive a response concerning the allegations in the complaint, staff will proceed with enforcement proceedings without your input. I urge you to respond to staff's request by providing a written statement concerning the alleged violations, and by amending your C-4 reports in accordance with [WAC 390-16-037](http://www.wa.gov/wacs/390-16-037).
