Dear Glen Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on April 11, 2018. Your complaint alleged that Angela Homola may have violated RCW 42.17A.235, .265, .205, .220, 320, .255 for failure to timely and accurately disclose contributions, expenditures, books of account, committee registration, and sponsor ID.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

- No evidence was provided to substantiate any allegations outside of late filing of C-3 and C-4 reports in violation of RCW 42.17A.235.
- The majority of the alleged violations were for timely filed or amended, C-3 and C-4 reports.
- Angela Homola admits to filing 7 late reports between 1-6 days late, and amending 3 C-3 reports to disclose \$553.02 or .2% of the campaign's contributions.

Based on these initial findings, staff has determined that in this instance, failure to timely file a small number of C-3 and C-4 reports covering minor activity, does not amount to an actual material violation warranting further investigation.

PDC staff is reminding Angela Homola, about the importance of the timely disclosure of all contribution and expenditure activities, including the filing fee, and the timely filings of all future PDC reports.

Based on this information, the PDC has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1), and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.
