Dear Glen Morgan:

This letter is to notify you that after conducting a preliminary review and assessment of the complaint you filed April 11, 2018 against WA Society of Certified Public Accountants, PDC staff opened a formal investigation on November 8, 2018, and held an Initial Hearing (Case Status Review Hearing) on November 14, 2018, pursuant to RCW 42.17A.755, and WACs 390-37-060 and 390-37-071.

RCW 42.17A.775 provides that a citizen may bring a citizen's action in the name of the state provided the PDC takes no action within 10 days of receipt of a 10-day notice letter. On November 5, 2018, the PDC received a 10-day notice letter. As described above, the PDC has taken action in this matter within the time-frame contemplated by the legislature.

After the PDC staff has completed its investigation, staff will inform you of the disposition of this case.
