File a Formal Complaint - Glen Morgan

To Whom it May Concern --

It has come to my attention that Melissa Denton (stealth candidate for Thurston County Commission District 3), her committee officers, and her committee treasurer (hereafter referred to collectively as "Melissa Denton") have habitually and willfully committed frequent and multiple violations of **RCW 42.17A**. Additionally, I have reason to believe that other violations of this chapter have occurred beyond what I have identified below.

1) Failure to timely file C-1. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.205)

State law requires that candidates/committees file their C1/C1-pc statement of organization within 2 weeks of becoming a candidate.

Melissa Denton publicly announced her candidacy on February 13, 2018 and had been soliciting contributions and endorsements since at least February 5, 2018.

Unfortunately she still has not submitted her C1 as required by law. This makes her more than a month late.

2) Failure to timely submit accurate F-1. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.700, .710)

Melissa Denton failed to submit an accurate F1 containing all the information required by state law within 14 days allowed by state law from the time she announced her candidacy.

Melissa Denton publicly announced her candidacy on February 13, 2018 and had been soliciting contributions and endorsements since at least February 5, 2018.

Unfortunately she still has not submitted her F1 as required by law. This makes her more than a month late.

The PDC should investigate the possibility that Melissa Denton committed the above violations maliciously, which would be a class C felony per RCW 42.17A.750 (2)(c). If the PDC determines that is the case, they should refer the case to the Attorney General's office for criminal prosecution immediately.
