Subject: Complaint regarding Lisa Homer, PDC Case 33750

Dear Sophie Holden:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on April 5, 2018. Your complaint alleged that Lisa Homer may have violated RCW 42.17A.205 for failure to timely file Candidate Registration (C-1 report) within two weeks of announcing candidacy for public office.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

- Lisa Homer publicly announced candidacy for Yakima County Commissioner, and per RCW 42.17A.205, was required to file a C-1 Candidate Registration form within two weeks of that declaration.
- As this announcement was publicized through a March 21, 2018 newspaper article, the C-1 was due within two weeks of the announcement, or not later than April 4, 2018.
- Lisa Homer is a first-time candidate who late filed a C-1 on April 10, 2018.

Based on these initial findings, staff has determined that in this instance, filing a C-1 Candidate Registration form six days late does not amount to a material violation warranting further investigation.

PDC staff is reminding Lisa Homer about the importance of the timely disclosure of all contribution and expenditure activities, including timely registration of campaigns. PDC staff expects the timely filing of all future PDC reports, including the C-1 report.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.
