Subject: Complaint regarding Rebecca Saldaña, PDC Case 28892

Dear Glen Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on December 18, 2017. Your complaint alleged that Rebecca Saldaña may have violated Chapter 42.17A RCW for failure to accurately and timely disclose contributions, expenditures, debts, committee officers, financial affairs, sponsor ID, and keep sufficient records.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

- Except for the alleged violations of RCW 42.17A.235, .700, and .710, the complainant provided no evidence to substantiate their claims.
- All save one C-3 filed one day late, the alleged violations of RCW 42.17A.235 were for amended reports or timely filed reports due after legal holidays.
- Rebecca Saldaña failed to timely file a post-appointment F-1 report in December 2016, disclosing financial affairs for twelve calendar months prior to appointment, as required by RCW 42.17A.700, but timely filed the F-1 report for her first year in office, on April 17, 2017.
- Rebecca Saldaña timely filed an F-1 supplement disclosing membership on the board of directors for Rainier Beach Action Coalition, after it incorporated in calendar year 2017, along with the timely filed F-1 report filed April 13, 2018.

Based on these initial findings, staff has determined that in this instance, failure to timely file a post-appointment personal financial affairs statement, and one C-3 report filed one day late, does not amount to an actual material violation warranting further investigation.

PDC staff is reminding Rebecca Saldaña about the importance of the timely filing of all contribution and expenditure reports. PDC staff expects that you will file timely reports of contributions and expenditures in future years in accordance with PDC laws and rules.

Based on this information, the PDC has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1), and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.
