To PDC & Compliance Coordinator, Micaiah Ragins:

I received written notice of the filing of a formal complaint yesterday. In chatting briefly with a representative from the PDC regarding this complaint, it was mentioned that it would be helpful to A) confirm or deny the allegations and B) if denying the allegations, provide rationale and support for the denial.

I have been working with the PDC and our team to improve this report since learning of errors weeks ago and have just resubmitted our C3-1 report to reflect a gift that was previously reported as anonymous. That part of the complaint should be corrected. This was an error on our part, but I believe it has been fixed. If further errors have been found in our reporting, I would love to have the opportunity to correct those mistakes as well.

The second part of the complaint seems to focus on the printing/distribution of the bond campaign fact sheet. This fact sheet was not created "for" the campaign committee. This was a document created by the school district for wide distribution to multiple groups throughout the community. We did distribute copies for the campaign. We do not believe this to be a violation, but would welcome the chance to address any more specific claims.

If you need further clarification on any matter, please write back. If you have instructions on how to correct our process, please let me know.
