Dear Glen Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review of the complaint you filed on November 30, 2017. Your complaint alleged that Sharon Wylie may have violated RCW 42.17A.235 and .430 for failure to timely and accurately disclose contributions, expenditures, and debt.

As a result of staff's review, we found the following: •

- The allegations contained in the complaint underlying PDC Case 28235 are substantially similar to a citizen action complaint, filed with the Attorney General's Office pursuant to RCW 42.17A.765.
- On May 29, 2018, PDC Staff became aware that a lawsuit containing substantially similar allegations as the complaint underlying PDC Case 28235 was filed in Superior Court in the name of Washington State.
- The Superior Court now has primary jurisdiction over the substance of this complaint; the PDC will defer to their judgment in bringing the issues to resolution.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.
