To Whom It May Concern:

Regarding Mr. Charlie Pancerzewski's November 26th complaint against Mukilteo for All, we provide the following in response:

- The PDC guidelines define a debt as "a promise to pay for goods or services or any offer to purchase advertising space, broadcast time or other advertising related product or service." The mailing service was provided by WinPower Strategies and so the obligation was to them and it was reported as such. Capitol City Press was a subvendor as reported. In addition, whether this obligation was reported as a loan or a debt, there would have been no material difference on the information disclosed.
- 2) The work was undertaken for the committee by our vendors with the expectation that funds could be raised to cover costs. As the election drew closer and it became apparent that our fundraising would not meet our initial expectations, we came to an agreement with our vendors that they contribute a portion of their services. It is a failure of imagination on Mr. Pancerzewski's part that people might want to contribute time and energy to prevent such a divisive, anti-Muslim figure from joining the city council of Mukilteo. These contributions were reported in a timely manner in the interest of transparency and as required by law.

We appreciate the opportunity to address these allegations and are happy to provide any additional information you may need.
