A: Payment of Contributions from 7th Legislative District Republican Party to Jacquelin Maycumber and Shelly Short campaigns in violation of session freeze

The Complaint claims that while in the midst of a special legislative session, the 7th Legislative District Republican Committee made contributions to Senator Shelly Short and Representative Jacquelin Maycumber's campaigns. The 7th Legislative District Republican Committee did not make any contributions during the special legislative session. The Committee purchased yard signs and 4' x 8' campaigns signs from Senator Short and Representative Maycumber's campaigns. According to an email from the Public Disclosure Commission, this is not a contribution, but is to be listed as miscellaneous income. Therefore, the 7th Legislative District Republican Committee did not make any contributions during the Legislative Freeze.
