To Whom It May Concern:

I write in response to Mr. Glen Morgan's tenth complaint concerning my 2017 campaign for State Senate in the 45th Legislative District, and again, I appreciate the opportunity to respond to Mr. Morgan's frivolous claims against my campaign, point by point. They are as follows:

1) Concerning late filing of reports

All filings listed in this complaint are amendments made to correct the record when new information became available. All original reports were filed in a timely manner.

2) Concerning the public inspection of campaign books.

The PDC guidelines on the public inspection of campaign books did not include loan agreements, only ledgers, so we did not include them in the materials provided for public inspection. In addition, the loans Mr. Morgan is referring to were not formal loans, but out-of-pocket expenditures made with my personal funds, and they were fully repaid months ago, in April 2017. We fail to see how they would be of any interest by the end of July.

3) Concerning the breakdown of expenditures

Mr. Morgan has purposefully omitted information from his list. We believe all expenditures have been described sufficiently in our filed reports, according to the commission's guidelines.
