

File a Formal Complaint - Terry Sayles

Mitch Short, husband of Senator Shelly Short started a political foundation some years back whose purpose was for Eastern Washington campaign contributors to have a way to support Republican candidates in Western Washington. Over the years several thousand dollars have been collected, yet I only was able to find one contribution from the foundation of about \$1,500.

Recently Mitch's wife, gave the foundation a \$10,000 contribution as well as Shelly's ex-aide and current State Representative Jacquelin Maycumber gave the foundation \$10,000 as well. I was told that Jacquelin had just received a \$10,000 donation from the State Republican Party a few days earlier.

I have searched the State website to find if the ROC or EWOC foundation is listed with the state and have not been able to locate either.

It appears that the ROC has received over \$110,000 in the past 5 years, and most, if not all from political candidates. As a Foundation, the ROC is supposed to be registered with the State of Washington, we can find no record of the ROC listed with the SOS.
