Dear Mr. Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review of the complaint you filed on Sept. 19, 2017. The complaint alleged the Clallam County Democratic Central Committee, may have violated RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 by failing to timely file the Summary Full Campaign Contribution and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports), including the 7-Day Pre-Primary Election C-4 report, disclosing contribution and expenditure information, including outstanding debts and obligations and providing the proper reporting breakdown for a number of expenditures made by the committee.

PDC staff reviewed the allegations listed in your complaint, and as a result of staff's review, we found the following:

- On July 31, 2018, PDC staff became aware that a lawsuit had been filed in Superior Court in the name of Washington State, containing substantially similar alleged violations of RCW 42.17A and WAC 390 as the complaint you filed with the PDC under Case 25576.
- Based on PDC statutes and rules, Superior Court has primary jurisdiction over the substance of this complaint, and the PDC defers to its judgment in bringing the allegations listed in your complaint to resolution.
