Dear Glen Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on September 29, 2018. Your complaint alleged that Kittitas County Democratic Central Committee may have violated Chapter 42.17A RCW for accepting over-limit anonymous contributions, failing to keep a log of small contributors, and failure to timely file reports of contributions and expenditures.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

- The allegations contained in the complaint underlying PDC Case 25514 are substantially similar to a citizen action complaint, filed with the Attorney General's Office pursuant to RCW 42.17A.765.
- On March 5, 2018, the PDC became aware that a lawsuit containing substantially similar allegations as the complaint underlying PDC Case 25514 was filed in Superior Court in the name of Washington State.
- The Superior Court now has primary jurisdiction over the substance of this complaint, and the PDC will defer to its judgment in bringing the issues to resolution.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.
