Subject: Complaint regarding Lisa Brown, PDC Case 25380

Dear Washington State Republican Party:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on September 21, 2017. Your complaint alleged that Lisa Brown may have violated RCW 42.17A.555 for misuse of public facilities to support her congressional campaign.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

- The PDC opened Case 25380 based upon the alleged facts of the Complaint on September 26, 2017.
- The Executive Ethics Board has jurisdiction over allegations of misuse of public facilities for state agencies, officials, and employees.

Based on these initial findings, staff has determined that in this instance, the PDC lacks jurisdiction to investigate the alleged violations.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing enforcement action in this case.
