Dear Glen Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on September 8, 2017. Your complaint alleged that Teresa Purcell may have violated by RCW 42.17A.235, RCW 42.17A.240, RCW 42.17A.320, and RCW 42.17A.700 for failure to timely and accurately disclose contributions, expenditures, debt, and political advertising.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

- The allegations contained in the complaint underlying PDC Case 25108 are substantially similar to a citizen action complaint, filed with the Attorney General's Office pursuant to RCW 42.17A.765.
- On December 27, 2017, the PDC became aware that a lawsuit containing substantially similar allegations as the complaint underlying PDC Case 25108 was included in a previous citizen action notice and that the remaining allegations of this third complaint was amended by the State in its civil enforcement action against Ms. Purcell for which there was factual support.
- The Superior Court now has primary jurisdiction over the substance of this complaint, and the PDC will defer to their judgment in bringing the issues to resolution.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.
