Dear Mary M Shepard:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on 8/27/2017. Your complaint alleged that Bryan Holloway may have violated RCW 42.17A.205 by failing to register as a candidate with the Public Disclosure Commission.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

- Bryan Holloway filed as a candidate with the King County elections, but was not registered with the Public Disclosure Commission.
- Bryan Holloway indicated that he experienced technical errors with filing electronically and believed that the C-1 registration worked.
- Bryan Holloway explained that he is self-funded and had no contributions or expenditures to report.
- Bryan Holloway does not have previous violations with filing with the PDC and he corrected the C-1 issue after he was notified.

Based on these initial findings, staff has determined that in this instance, the failure to timely file the C-1 candidate registration report for the 2017 election does not amount to a material violation warranting further investigation.

PDC staff is reminding Bryan Holloway about the importance of timely filing the candidate registration report and ensuring that he checks for the confirmation email when filing the C-1 report electronically.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.
