Subject: Complaint regarding 46th District Democrats, PDC Case 24634

Dear Glen Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on August 12, 2017. Your complaint alleged that the 46th District Democrats may have violated by RCW 42.17A.235, RCW 42.17A.240, and RCW 42.17A.205 for failure to timely or accurately disclose contributions, expenditures, debt, and committee officers.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

- The allegations contained in the complaint underlying PDC Case 24634 are substantially similar to a citizen action complaint, filed with the Attorney General's Office pursuant to RCW 42.17A.765.
- On December 4, 2017, the PDC became aware that a lawsuit containing substantially similar allegations as the complaint underlying PDC Case 24634 was filed in Superior Court.
- The Superior Court now has primary jurisdiction over the substance of this complaint, and the PDC will defer to their judgment in bringing the issues to resolution.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.
