

File a Formal Complaint - Glen Morgan

To Whom it May Concern --

It has come to my attention that Kelsey Hulse has continued to violate our campaign finance laws despite settling her lawsuit with the Attorney General's office on March 6, 2017 (**Thurston County Case #17-2-00848-34**)

failed to file her C4 for the month of July, as required by **RCW 42.17A.235**. Additionally, she has failed to list her legal debt that is resulting from a lawsuit the AG filed against her and her committee.

1) Hulse continues to owe nearly \$5000 to a vendor she accepted a massive overlimit in-kind contribution from. As such, she must continue to file until this debt is extinguished.

A C4 for July was due on August 10th, but she failed to submit this (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235).

Please ensure that Hulse files her C4 immediately.

At some point the PDC probably needs to determine how long they will allow Hulse to carry this debt to Ms. Davison. It has been nine months since Hulse illegally accepted this overlimit in-kind donation from Ms. Davison. If there is ultimately no time limit to reimburse illegal overlimit donations, then the PDC will be inadvertently erasing campaign finance donation limits.

2) Hulse failed to list legal expenses and debt that resulted from a lawsuit that the AG filed against her and her committee. According to records, she is being actively represented by Pacifica Law Group. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240)

3) Hulse failed to list her settlement fines and fees that resulted from her settlement with the Attorney General's office on March 6, 2017 (Thurston County Court Case #17-2-00848-34). According to court settlement records, she had to pay \$2,405, which was due by April 6, 2017. To date, this has not been reported (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240)

Please ensure that Hulse amends her C4 covering the time period of June to make sure this is reported correctly.
