Hello Micaiah Titus Ragins,

This is a response to the complaint of Monday July 17, 2017 by Johna Thompson.

1. The complaint refers to a 8.5x14" glossy flyer. I do not know who created or paid for these. They are not part of a campaign sponsored by me. The flyer gives contact information at the very bottom. So hopefully you can find any useful information from the last part of the flyer.

2. The complaint of Thompson also refers to yard signs and a website. I did not pay for or have knowledge of the creation of these. An acquaintance suggested that I look at the website so I followed up and asked who created it. I believe one could contact Bill McDermant (bmcder3674@aol.com) or Judy Carrier (gotrocks886@msn.com) for information on the signs and website.

3. Finally. Regarding funds being spent on legal defense: I have retained an attorney and have incurred expenses for a legal appeal in state court. I have not considered these expenses to be a campaign related expenditure.

I hope this response properly addressed the issues raised in the Thompson complaint.
