Subject: Complaint regarding Todd Starkey, PDC Case 23121

Dear Glen Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on July 17, 2017. Your complaint alleged that Todd Starkey may have violated RCW 42.17A.205 for failure to timely file a C-1 candidate registration, and RCW 42.17A.700 for failure to timely file an F-1 statement of personal financial affairs.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

- Todd Starkey was required to file a C-1 and F-1 within two weeks of becoming a candidate in accordance with RCW 42.17A.205 and RCW 42.17A.700 respectively, not later than June 2, 2017.
- Todd Starkey filed a C-1 on July 21, 2017 and an F-1 on July 24, 2017, prior to hearing notices being issued for failure to file.
- Todd Starkey is a first-time candidate with no prior violations.

Based on these initial findings, staff has determined that in this instance, failure to timely file the C-1 candidate registration form and F-1 statement of personal financial affairs does not amount to a material violation warranting further investigation.

Pursuant to WAC 390-37-060(1)(b), Todd Starkey will receive a formal written warning concerning the failure to timely file a C-1 candidate registration form and F-1 statement of personal financial affairs. The formal written warning will include staff's expectation that Todd Starkey files timely and complete reports in future years in accordance with PDC laws and rules. The Commission will consider the formal written warning in deciding on further Commission action if there are future violations of PDC laws or rules.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.

The complaint alleged that you may have violated RCW 42.17A.205 for failure to timely file a C-1 candidate registration and RCW 42.17A.700 for failure to timely file an F-1 statement of personal financial affairs. As noted in the letter to Glen Morgan, the PDC will not be conducting a more formal investigation into these allegations or taking further enforcement action in this matter. PDC Staff expects you to file timely and complete reports in future years in accordance with PDC laws and rules.
