

In Hopkins' most recent F-1 financial disclosure report, there are a number of irregularities. These include the omission of the following.

1. Real Estate ownership as a 50% partner in East Main Investments is listed, but the properties are not identified.
2. Failure to disclose ownership in properties in downtown Puyallup understood to be solely owned by Hopkins and his spouse. Examples include a restaurant at 109 W Pioneer, a property on Meeker Ave, the former Puyallup Herald office, the former cheese shop on Meridian, the Hearing Aid shop on Meridian, the former State Senator Kastama office. Some of these properties are listed with the County Treasurer/Assessor as being co-owned by Hopkins and his spouse.
3. It is understood that Hopkins owns a condo in downtown Seattle where his daughter resides
4. It is understood Hopkins owns a house and acreage on Canyon Rd in Puyallup where his son resides.
5. Hopkins owns at least one house in the UK (Isle of Wight) of significant value.

Hopkins fails to indicate revenue income from his commercial properties which he listed that are solely owned, not part of main street investments.

Secondly, without the properties described which are part of his main st investment business, it is impossible to tell whether revenue amount category "c" is reasonably legitimate.
