On behalf of the Master Builders Assn of King and Snohomish Counties – Affordable Housing Council (MBA/AHC), I am responding to your August 2, 2017 email request for a response to a complaint filed with your office by Jason Antonelli.

Mailings supporting Byron Shutz and Roy Captain for city council were mailed to voters on July 19, 2017, and could have been received by members of the public by July 20, 2017 at the earliest. On July, 28, 2017, MBA/AHC staff determined that an internal communications process within MBA/AHC was not functioning properly and that a C-6 had not been filed for these expenditures. That same day, the MBA/AHC filed a C-6.

Since that date, the MBA/AHC has conducted an internal gap analysis and implemented structural changes to ensure no future communications failures going forward. MBA/AHC is confident that all current C-3, C-4, and C-6 reporting obligations to the PDC are met.
