We followed the PDC guidelines. The adds were place in the "Splash" and paid for by the Committee. Her picture is blurry. I do not have a copy of that ad in my computer as it was created by the Splash using info from last year. I am attaching the Ad we did for end of July.

The mailer was the City fact postcard mailed to all residents. It was not done by the Friends of Town Square. I would direct you to Katy Allen the City of Liberty Lake administrator and the City's attorney.

On May 23, 2017 around 8am, I spoke with Chip Beatty of your office and asked how I should file for the campaign in 2017. He instructed me to go on line and file electronically and change the election date. I did that on that morning. I believed it was submitted but it could have been done in draft. I was of the impression that everything went well. In late June or early July one of our councilmembers spoke with a lady, I believe Jennifer at PDC and could not find a record. I tried to call Jennifer repeatedly after this came to my attention and not being able to successfully reach her but only the voice mail, I filed again to insure it was done.

Finally, I believe that we tried to follow the instructions of the PDC .
